



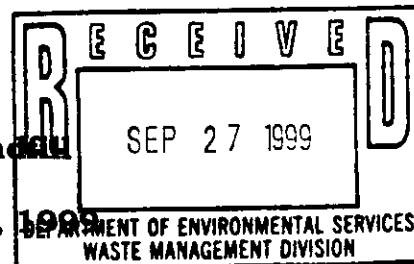

Dear Mr. Bowen:

This letter is prepared in response to the above-referenced NHDES request for information concerning disposal of leachate generated in Stage I - Phase III of the North Country Environmental Services, Inc. (NCES) landfill in Bethlehem, New Hampshire.

We have attached the following information requested by NHDES in the September 10, 1999 correspondence:


1. Stage I - Phase III analytical results sampled after January 1, 1999. These reports include results for samples collected in February, April, May, and July 1999.
2. Waste manifests for each load of Stage I - Phase III leachate shipped off-site after January 1, 1999. Four loads were sent to United Oil Recovery in Meriden, Connecticut during January and February 1999. The remainder of the loads through the current date were sent to Dupont Environmental Treatment in Deepwater, New Jersey.
3. Table of Stage I - Phase III data which summarizes the date shipped, gallons transported, disposal facility, and transporter for each load shipped after January 1, 1999.
4. Invoices for loads of Stage I - Phase III leachate sent for disposal after January 1, 1999.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Scope. Earthwatch Waste Systems, Inc. (EWS) agrees to accept from the Customer Acceptable Solid Waste for transportation and/or disposal at the Disposal Facility described above. For this Agreement, Acceptable Solid Waste shall consist of non-toxic, non-hazardous and putrescible and non-putrescible materials or substances, including pre-approved industrial wastes and contaminated soils that are discarded or rejected as being spent, useless, or worthless.
- Unacceptable Waste. The customer shall not offer or deliver through EWS any waste that is unacceptable or prohibited for disposal at the Disposal Facility. Unacceptable Waste shall include but not be limited to: (a) any material that by reason of its composition, characteristics, physical state, or quantity is inadvisable for handling, processing and/or disposal at the Disposal Facility, (b) RCRA hazardous, toxic, radioactive, medical, hospital or laboratory wastes or substances as defined as hazardous by applicable federal, state, or local laws or regulations; (c) any other material that EWS reasonably concludes would require special handling or present an endangerment to the Disposal Facility, the public health or safety, or the environment, and (d) any and all items prohibited by any applicable law, regulation, or the USEPA, or other governmental authority. All risks, responsibilities, fines, and other costs associated with events involving Unacceptable or prohibited waste shall be borne by the Customer. In the event that Unacceptable Waste is delivered to EWS's vehicles and/or the Disposal Facility pursuant to this Agreement, any and all cost incurred by EWS and/or its subcontractors with respect to such Unacceptable waste, including any fines or penalties assessed therefore or costs for return of such Unacceptable waste to the generator shall be the responsibility of the Customer and shall be promptly paid by the Customer. Acceptance of a delivery by EWS shall not create any presumption that the delivery did not contain Unacceptable Waste, whether or not such delivery was inspected or tested. If the Customer provides for their own transportation, they must do so in accordance with all applicable health, safety, and environmental standards and be solely responsible for such transport.
- Title. Title to the Acceptable Solid Waste delivered by Customer shall be transferred to and rest with the Disposal Facility at the time the Acceptable Solid Waste is fully unloaded at the Disposal Facility and the delivery vehicle has departed the Disposal Facility's property. Prior thereto, full title to the Acceptable Solid Waste shall remain with the Customer, and all risks and responsibilities therefore shall be borne by the Customer.
- Indemnity. Customer hereby agrees to indemnify and hold EWS harmless from and against any and all loss, damage, suits, liability and expenses (including, but not limited to, reasonable investigation and legal expenses) arising out of or from any claim for loss of or damage to property, including the Disposal Site property, and injuries to or death of persons, including Customer's or the Disposal Facility employees, and government imposed fines or remedial costs caused by or resulting from the negligence or willful misconduct or violation of any federal, state or local laws or regulations by Customer, its employees or agents. The provisions of this paragraph 4 shall survive the termination of this agreement.
- Term. This Agreement and the pricing stated herein shall remain in effect from 1/29/99 through 12/31/99. Written notice of price increase or decrease due to changes in disposal, transportation, or regulatory fees incurred by EWS will be provided to the Customer and such notice shall be an amendment to this Agreement unless Customer objects thereto in writing within 10 days of mailing in which case this Agreement shall terminate. The effective date of any price change shall be the 15th day after mailing of this notice.
- Force Majeure. Except for the obligation to pay for services rendered, neither party hereto shall be liable for its failure to perform hereunder due to contingencies beyond its reasonable control, including, but not limited to, strikes, riots, war, fire, acts of God, compliance with any law, regulation or order, whether valid or invalid, of the United States of America or any other governmental body or any instrumentality thereof, whether now existing or hereafter created, or the revocation, suspension, denial or modification of any permit, license or approval regarding use, operation or closure of the Disposal Facility.
- Assignment. This Agreement is assignable only with the prior written consent of both parties and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
- Payment and Terms. Payment of EWS invoices for services described herein shall be paid in full by the Customer in Net 30 (in words: thirty) Days. Late payments are subject to interest charges as described in the EWS Application for Credit. Shipment weights and volumes are determined exclusively by the Disposal Facility, and the Customer agrees to honor these determinations as described on the Disposal Facility's certified weight or disposal receipt. The customer grants EWS the right to offset any amounts that become due under this agreement against any monies owed by EWS to the customer.
- Miscellaneous. This Agreement shall be governed and construed under New York State law. For purposes of any proceeding involving this Agreement, the parties hereby submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of New York located in Erie County, New York. Customer agrees to pay EWS's cost of collection for any amounts due under this Agreement including interest (as stipulated in the EWS Application for Credit), court costs and reasonable attorney fees. An executed facsimile transmission of this Agreement shall be legally binding.
- Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between EWS and Customer, and cancels and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, understandings and agreements, whether written or oral, with respect to the subject matter hereof. No changes, alterations or modification to this Agreement will be effective unless in writing and signed by EWS and Customer, except for price changes as set forth in Section 5.
