Request for Site Survey / Capacity Analysis Information**

Dear Mr. Gay:

The site survey information provided in the above-referenced revised 2019 Annual Facility Report is insufficient as supporting documentation for the required analysis of the remaining permitted capacity of the subject facility at the end of calendar year 2019. The plan sheet you submitted provides no topographical contours showing the surveyed elevations compared to the permitted finished grades. No calculations were provided to support the analysis of remaining volume. We are unable to read the stamp of the licensed professional that prepared the plan. And, the remaining capacity analysis, to the extent one was provided, is not submitted under the cover of the licensed professional that performed the analysis and made the necessary calculations.

Therefore, pursuant to Env-Sw 2002.01(f), the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division, Solid Waste Management Bureau (NHDES) requests that North Country Environmental Services, Inc. (NCES) submit the required analysis of remaining capacity of the facility based on a site survey, per Env-Sw 806.08(j)(2)b, and include the documentation needed to support the analysis.
