TAKE NOTICE THAT YOU,

ARE PROHIBITED FROM trespassing against persons and property upon on the property at:

At any time for any reason whatsoever except with a valid warrant to enter.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that should you enter upon the said property contrary to this Notice, you may be charged or in the case of forced entry without a valid warrant for the property will be defended from this unlawful entry.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that failure to comply is an offence pursuant to the Section 9(1) of the Trespass to Property Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. T.21, and the Criminal Code of Canada. You may be convicted when arrested, and on conviction, be fined or jailed or the occupiers may use force against you pursuant to section 34 of the Criminal Code of Canada.
