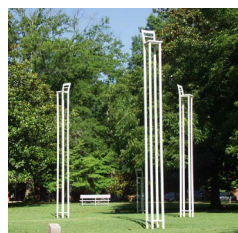

Women's Art Initiative

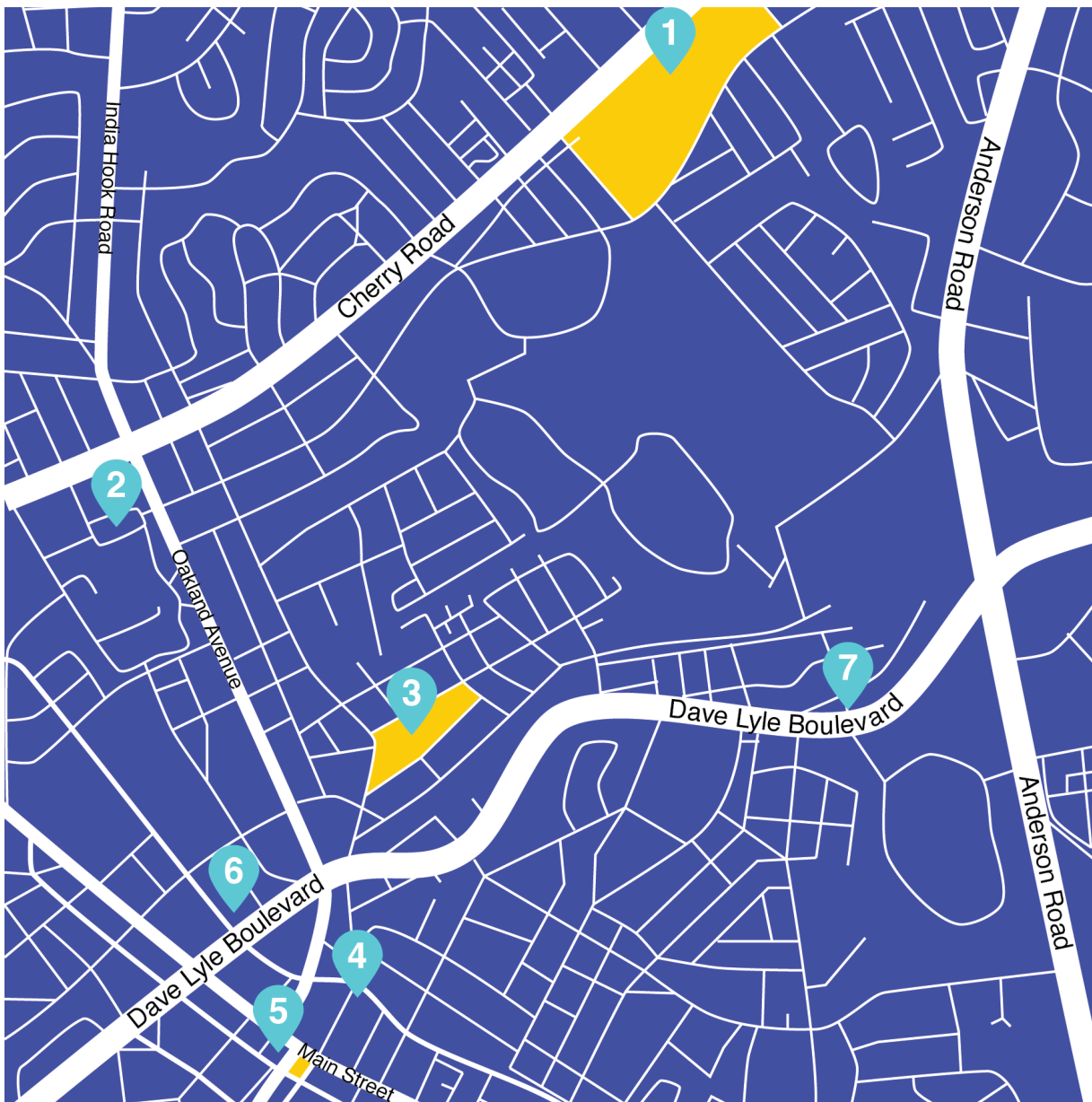


The Women's Art Initiative was created to enhance Rock Hill's quality of life through public art.
