How is CDCUSA Funded?

CDCUSA conducts <u>Start & End Programs & Projects</u>. Once a need or program is identified in a community, an assessment is performed. That assessment identifies the need as a fee for service program or a community service program / project

- A budget is put together for that program / project.
- A funding / revenue source is identified Fees –Donation–Grants-other
- A start date selected
- Program begins-operates with a predetermined end date or as ongoing as needed

What is Fee for Service Programs?

CDCUSA may charge a fee for program services – Childcare, First-aid / CPR, Day Camp –These are Net Gain Programs

What are CDCUSA Service Programs?

CDCUSA May support /conduct Service Programs that have a Net \$ loss. These programs contribute back to the greater community. They may be funded by a grant or local in-kind / cash donations or through the net gain programs

How is the money Spent?

\$0.85 Cents of every \$ collected goes to Direct Net Gain and Service Program Delivery

\$0.15 Cents of every \$ collected goes to Administration. Admin costs include Insurance and other cost of doing business expenses.

NOTE: Not every program or service contributes to Administration
