It's an action-packed series of events, including visits to three of the Caribbean's premier rum distilleries: Mount Gay, West Indies and St Nicholas Abbey.

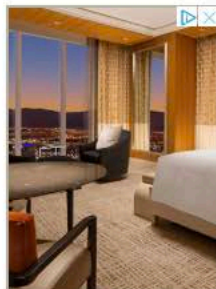
That's along with rum education seminars, rum shop stops and rum-fueled dinners.
