

New Plants List 2024

Vegetables

Pepper, Hot *Ghost, Thai Hot*

Coming in at 1 million Scovilles, the Ghost pepper was Guinness World Records certified as the hottest chili pepper in the world in 2007. Thai Hot is a small fiery chili pepper commonly used in Thai cuisine.

Pepper, Sweet *Escamillo*

Golden yellow counterpart to the Carmen pepper that is a refined take on the Corno di Toro pepper class. Traditionally used for frying.

Annuals

Calibrachoa *Minifamous Double Deep Yellow*

Another addition to our popular line of double Callies. This one features a deeper yellow color than our traditional lemon.

Hypoestes *Confetti Compact Pink*

In addition to our red and white polka dot plants, we will now have a pink version available. A low mound of foliage that looks good by itself or outstanding when mixed with other plants.

Mandevilla *Sunbeam*

Yellow Mandevilla with a bushier habit. Great for sunny spots to add a tropical look.

Marigold *Happy Series, Superhero Spry*

The Happy Series of Marigolds, consisting of Happy Yellow, Happy Orange and Happy Spry will replace our Hot Pak series. Happy Marigolds are one of the most compact varieties for small spaces or front of borders. Superhero Spry was an All-American Selection Winner in 2018. A beautiful crested French Marigold with burgundy and gold blooms.

New Guinea *Petticoat Series*

Replacing our Paradise New Guineas, the Petticoat series are earlier to bloom with a wide range of unique colors and patterns.

Petunia *Easy Wave Burgundy Star*

A unique addition to our Easy Wave Petunias. Burgundy Star has burgundy flowers adorned with a white star pattern.

Supertunia *Hoopla Vivid Orchid*

Purple flowers with a bright white edge. Vigorous growth quickly fills in to provide continuous color.

Tradescantia *Nanouk*

Green, pink and white stripes on lush leaves. Great for partial shade baskets or used as a houseplant.

Perennials

Agastache *Little Adder*

A compact Agastache with even more flower power than other common varieties.

Anemone *Pamina*

Double deep-rose flowers from late summer into fall. Adds color to the garden when other flowers are starting to fade.

Astilbe *Ostrich Plume*

Stunning pink weeping panicles on arching stems. Young foliage may be tinged with bronze.

Clematis *Duchess of Cornwall*

Early season flowers will be a violet blue with repeat flowering being a darker violet that softens to a mid-blue color.

New Plants List 2024

Echinacea

Cara Mia Yellow, Moab Sunset, Parrot

Two new double Coneflowers, Cara Mia Yellow with yellow blooms and Moab Sunset featuring orange flowers. Parrot will be a bright addition to any garden with its golden yellow petals and vibrant, red halos.

Grass

Schizachyrium Little Red Fox

Little Bluestem Grass is a native grass commonly found in prairies and open woodlands throughout North America. Has excellent drought tolerance, disease resistance and wildlife habitat. Attractive blue-green foliage in spring that turns a reddish-orange in fall.

Hibiscus

Mocha Moon

Another hardy Hibiscus with dark foliage. The pure white flowers with a scarlet red eye stand out against the dark leaves.

Lilium

Solution

Oriental Lily with large fragrant white flowers that has raspberry speckles and streaks of deep pink.

Monarda

Bee-You Bee Free, Bee-You Bee Happy, Bee-You Bee Lieve, Midnight Oil

Bee-You Monardas are a compact, mildew-resistant series of Bee Balm. Bee Free is bright purple, Bee Happy is hot pink magenta and Bee Lieve is soft pink. Midnight Oil is an excellent native cultivar. It sets itself apart with its chocolatey bronze foliage and light lavender flowers spotted with wine-colored freckles.

Orederia

Fusion of Fire

An intergeneric combination of Mukdenia and Oresitrophe, 'Fusion of Fire' takes the best of both plants for a one-of-a-kind new perennial. Notched leaves and brilliant red fall color comes from the Mukdenia, while Oresitrophe provides the massive leaves and blushing pink flowers in spring.

Tiarella

Pink Skyrocket

Large dense spikes of sparkling pink flowers. Makes a great addition to any woodland garden.

Vernonia

Iron Butterfly

Showy selection of Letterman's Ironweed, a native wildflower from Arkansas. Densely branched with finely textured foliage and bright violet-purple flowers in late summer. Attracts butterflies and bees and is a drought tolerant plant.

Nursery

Juniperus

Hetzi Columnar

Popular evergreen tree known for its toughness and versatility. Both salt and wind tolerant. Can be used for various purposes such as privacy screening and wind barriers.

Magnolia

Galaxy

An early hybrid with very dark purple buds that open to medium purple 8" flowers. Its upright habit make it perfect for narrow spaces and smaller landscapes.

Rose

Brickhouse Pink, Gilded Sun, Pretty Polly

Brickhouse Pink is a very compact Floribunda variety with fluorescent pink flowers that bloom continuously from spring until frost. Gilded Sun has excellent yellow, non-fading color and exceptional disease resistance. Pretty Polly is a pink Polyantha Rose with very good disease resistance and exceptional flowering from spring through fall.

Vaccinium

Legacy

This northern highbush variety is a late ripener, extending your harvest. Produces an abundant crop of medium sized, light blue sweet berries.
