

Historic Business District (HBD) Design Review: Application Process

The Design Review Board serves a vital purpose in shaping the physical image of Blackstone's Historic Business District (HBD) as a destination that's attractive to shoppers, investors, business/property owners, and visitors by adopting a specific approach for physical improvements to buildings, as well as public spaces.

Before submitting your request, include the following attachments (if applicable):

- 1. Fully completed Design Review Application
- 2. Image of applicant's business/building (street view)
- 3. Image or detailed drawing of proposed signage or exterior improvement
- 4. Color swatch that indicates desired paint color adheres to Benjamin Moore's Historical Collection A color swatch board can be referenced
- 5. Dimensions of proposed signage, as well as the area, i.e. window, etc., where proposed signage will be installed
- 6. Image of area where proposed signage will be installed
- 7. Any or all materials that you believe will aid the decision-making process

NOTE:

- No permits shall be issued by the Town of Blackstone until a Certificate of Appropriateness has been issued by the Design Review Board.
- The Town of Blackstone's HBD Sign Guidelines are attached for review.
- Applications can be submitted via email, mail, or in person. Please allow at least 2-3 days for an initial response to your request. If necessary, the Design Review Board will meet with the business/property owner to discuss their application or any decisions that are made, regarding the applicant's request.
