Fire Bans

We had an early start to the fire ban season this summer. Please follow all posted fire bans, with no exceptions. For up to date information, please download the Alberta Fire Bans app and sign up for alerts for South Baptiste. This will allow you to receive alerts as the information changes.

South Baptiste follows the rules set by the Forest Protection Area as we are located fully inside it. This is why you may notice from time to time that we differ from the bans noted in Athabasca County. We do reserve the right to enforce more strict bans than the forest protection area if we feel it is necessary.

Property Tax Notices

You will notice that your property tax notice came later this year. This was due to the change in administration. We have changed the deadline to August 31 and this will be a permanent change allowing residents more time to pay your property taxes.

No Wake Zones

Respect the lake and protect the shoreline. Slow to speeds of 10 km/h or less within 30m of the shoreline. Keep to the deep areas when enjoying higher speed activities.
