About 3,200 Sq Ft. This house sits on three acres in a desirable township with 200 ft frontage. To take advantage of the large three-acre lot, two large decks were built on the front and back of the house. Notice the separate in-law suite with full bathroom and kitchen

A large deck was added to both the front and back.





The deck is being painted to enhance its curb appeal.







The high quality slate roof was professionally repaired. All cracked and dislogged slates were replaced and a new steal ridge installed.

Kitchen:

Originally the kitchen was about half the size. There was a wall which created a separate room. The entire house was stripped down to the studs. The entire house has new insulation, HVAC, ducts and electic wiring was installed.

The wall in the photo below was removed to enlarge the kitchen to 33ft x 14ft.








Electric wires and ductwork needed to be removed and reinstalled to accommodate removing the wall to expand the kitchen.







New outlets, switches and lighting was added throughout the kitchen:










A sliding door was installed to access the large back deck from the kitchen.


Soffits were added which contain ventilation to outside, plumbing and electrical:







A new floor was installed. First the existing floor needed to be repaired where the wall was removed, then leveled in preparation for new flooring:












The counter and island will have top quality granite. The granite is already ordered and paid.


In addition, the kitchen will have all new appliances which are already ordered and paid.

Next to the stairs leading to the second floor, a new full bathroom was added:











The ceramic tile is already purchased and on site.

There are four full bathrooms. Originally this house had only one. All four bathrooms will have new vanity, fixtures, toilet, bath / shower and ceramic tile. All plumbing and electrical is new.

The fireplace is a wood burning and gas. The brick will be painted white to match the trim, baseboards and crown moldings.


The sunroom floors will match the kitchen floor. The subfloor is new double ¾ inch plywood.















The room in the basement above will be turned into a wine tasting cellar. Our goal is to turn an ugly basement into a selling feature.
