HELP KEEP THIS PLAY EQUIPMENT COVID-19 SECURE

All playground visitors are encouraged to note and follow the following guidance:

1. **You must not use the play equipment if you or anyone in your household has COVID-19 symptoms.**
2. Children should not use this equipment if they are clinically or extremely clinically vulnerable.
3. **If you develop COVID-19 symptoms within 7 days** of visiting the playground alert Test, Track and Trace. Alert the Village Hall Chairman, Chris Bradbury on 07472 272484.
4. The play equipment is checked regularly for damage and wear and tear, but is not sanitised or disinfected.
5. The play equipment is shared equipment, with use at the users own risk.
6. Parents and carers should encourage children not to put their mouths on play equipment and to avoid touching their faces.
7. **Maintain 2 metres social distancing as far as possible.** Follow the current social distance guidelines when visiting, with parents and carers encouraging children to do the same. You **must** maintain social distancing from others unless they are from the same household.
8. Some equipment can only be used by one child at a time while social distancing. Please ensure your family waits at a safe distance if the equipment is in use or return later to use the equipment.
9. If the playground is busy, consider coming back at a later time.
10. **Avoid touching your face, nose, or eyes.** Clean your hands if you do.
11. **“Catch it, Bin it, Kill it”.** Tissues should be disposed of in a litter bin or taken home. Then wash your hands.
12. If disposable masks, face coverings or gloves etc are worn, they should be disposed by placing them in a litter bin or taking home. Littering is not acceptable.
13. Visitors are encouraged to wash their hands, with hand sanitiser if needed, regularly and as a minimum before and after using the play equipment. Wash your hands when you get home for 20 seconds using soap and water.
14. **Wash your clothes when you get home** to reduce risk of transmission.
