David W. Kopachik
1946-2022

He fought the good fight...Courageous, honorable, dignified to the end. In the wee hours of March 10, David, "...slipped the surly bonds of earth...and touched the face of God".

David was born in Cleveland, Ohio to Bill and Elvira Kopachik. He attended parochial school from Kindergarten thru grade 12.

1964-1970 he attended various colleges, Cleveland State, Bowling Green, Kent State, U of FL. Between the schools, he had 170 credits; but never graduated. That was always a running joke in his family. His senior year he was drafted into the US Army during the turbulent political Viet Nam era.

He married Carolyn Majewski in 1970. Shortly after, he was sent to Viet Nam. While in VN, his first son, Erik, was born in 1971. David & Carolyn moved to FL upon his departure from the military. David went to work for the Tampa Fire Dept; raising thru the ranks to become Captain; he was known as "Captain K". His 2nd son, Kyle, was born in 1976. The marriage ended in divorce in 1984.

At his retirement, David moved to Oregon. He considered Oregon, "God's gift to the universe".

He met and married his wife, Christine in 2000. In his retirement, he started a business, "Think Paint" and became a successful paint contractor. In 2004, David and Christine bought a historical farmhouse and opened a B & B, The White House. His Corvette and the B&B were true loves. The White House hosted retreats, weddings, reunions, parties, church festivals and Corvettes in the Park.

Travel abroad and the USA were a passion. He loved baseball, fishing, hunting, camping, gardening, fast cars, UO sports, and was a voracious reader, as well as a model train enthusiast. In his retirement he was involved with Habitat for Humanity, Cascade Corvette Club, Northwest Steelheaders, Prospectors & Golddiggers, VFW. He was a devout Catholic throughout his life.

He is survived by his wife, Christine; sons Erik & Kyle; stepson, Tim; stepdaughters Rachel, Kelly, brother Will, sisters Dawn & Sheila. He took great joy in all aspects (birthdays, sports, plays, music, art, education) of the 7 beloved grandchildren he leaves behind.

March 31, 2022

Cascade Corvette Club was given the opportunity to get “hands on” with a community project we have been involved with since 2020. September of 2020 saw the most destructive wildfires Western Oregon has seen in hundreds of years. We became involved with the effort to assist victims of the Holiday Farm Fire which devastated the McKenzie River Valley and completely destroyed the community of Blue River.

One Hope / Sheds of Hope has built over 130 sheds for homeowners to store equipment necessary to their rebuilding efforts. Our benefit Car Show in 2021 provided them with \$7000 toward the purchase of materials. Partnering with local high schools, they have developed a program to build the modular sheds, which are then transported to the recipients homesite where a team of volunteers erect the shed complete with a shingle roof. Today that team was from Cascade Corvette Club.

Thanks to the able leadership of Jeff, Kenny and Steve, we were able to erect the building in just under four hours.



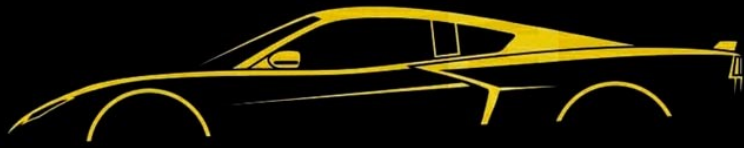
