We are not asked to put our faith in words alone, but in all the signs that Jesus worked and still works in our midst to show us that the reign of God is real, and is the source of joy for a world that cannot quite imagine the wholeness that salvation offers (a meditation from the Magnificat today on Psalm 89).

What a relevant introduction to the work that LLP is doing. I have often thought LLP should have as its mission statement: "Listen, Love, Pray....Encounter." LLP has the singular gift of being able to solicit the presence of God. The prayer ministers at LLP are very sensitive and loving, without bringing too much of themselves into the equation.

I am so glad to have joined in on the 'workshops' you offered this fall. The wonderful session on the Holy Spirit - the 'paddling out' one- kept me focused on a goal each day and was very fruitful. The more recent intensive prayer also really led me into the presence of the movement of the Holy Spirit.

I am noticing a subtle but marked improvement in many of my conditions. And this holiday is the first one in decades that I have been able to maintain a holy detachment, staying relatively calm and not so overstimulated and in a state of nervous, overwhelmed, worried misery. I also experienced an unprecedented inner joy and gratitude---so unprecedented that at first I did not recognize it for what it was. It seems sometimes God works in an immediate way and sometimes more gradually.

I'm so grateful for all that you all have done for me. This transformation that is taking place in me is a wonderful thing to behold, as is the protection and peace I had during my recent surgery ordeal.

A Message from the Executive Director

When was the last time you actually heard someone knocking at your door? Even before the pandemic, impromptu guests rarely appeared. Usually a text "on my way" or "here" negated any surprise.

From another perspective, there is no lack of unwelcome visitors who attempt to gain entry to heart and home. Some constantly bang on the door, shouting, "Look at this fearful headline!" or "Worry about this horrible thing that might happen!" or "Go ahead and despair because nothing will ever change." Other wanna-be guests slyly offer sweet temptations or clever twists of the truth to gain access.

Jesus is also knocking. He says, "Look, here I stand at the door and knock. If you hear me calling and open the door, I will come in and we will share a meal as

friends. (*Revelation 3:20*)" The Passion Translation says it a little differently, "Behold, I'm standing at the door, knocking. If your heart is open to hear my voice you can open the door within, I will come into you and feast with you and you will feast with me."

During recovery-ladies Bible study last week, we discussed this verse and someone commented that Jesus is the only one who she would open the door to, without feeling the need to clean up. Everyone else who knocked at her door might judge or make a comment about the untidiness of her life. But not Jesus. Jesus just wants to be with us, she said. Jesus wants to let us experience His love.

A new year might be the perfect time to consider what has gained access to your

heart and home. In the prolonged uncertainty and upheaval of the pandemic, perhaps you have unwelcomed intruders of fear, isolation, anxiety, stress, worry, panic, depression, frustration, and anger to name a few. The good news is that we don't have to "clean up" before opening the door to Jesus. In fact, Jesus wants to work right alongside us, helping us remove the stains, repair broken pieces, and restore balance. And He does it all with a love that makes our lives sparkle with renewed purpose and joy.

Happy New Year?

Yes! And Amen! When the Lord of Lords walks through the opened door.

15 LLP Recovery-Ministry volunteers logged **96 hours** supporting God's people in December alone!

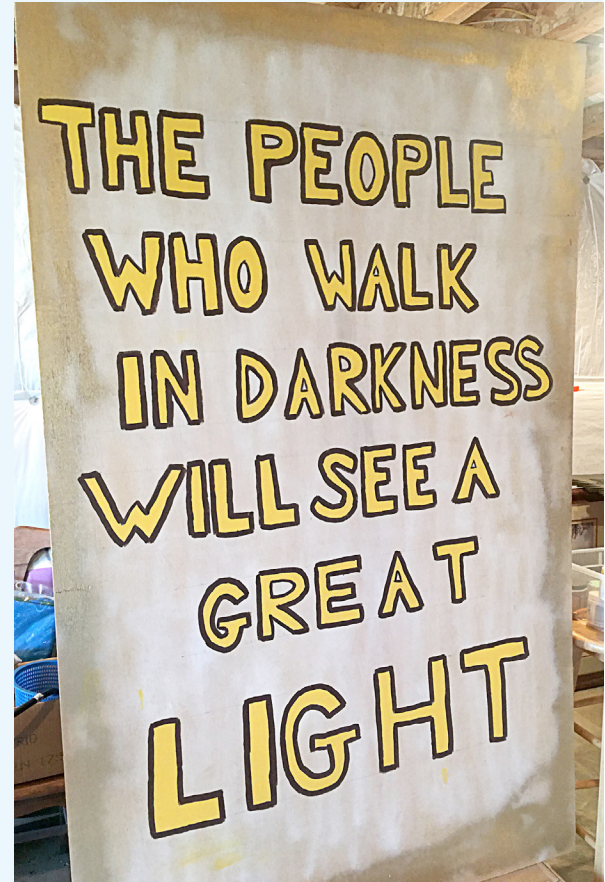
Jesus is leading folks in recovery **out of the darkness and into the light.**

- Donating fresh oranges, grapefruit and tangerines for the men at Beacon House
- Delivering oodles of toiletries to the women at Up and Out Sober Living
- Giving 8 individual healing prayer sessions
- Writing and leading 6 unique, Holy-Spirit led lessons

How did all of the efforts by the LLP ministers help the residents in recovery?

- "I was ready to relapse and filled with guilt and shame. I called my friend. We breathed together and prayed to God. I didn't relapse."
- "I came out of denial with the way I feel about my family. I made amends to them and now give back and help them out."
- "My hope is to be the shepherd that leads my children to Jesus."
- "I started out in the dark and now I am coming to the light."
- "I now know Jesus!"
- "Jesus is my one and only path to heaven."
- "Jesus is my rock, my father, my friend, my hope, and my strength."
- "Jesus saved me from my sad, sad, low depression."

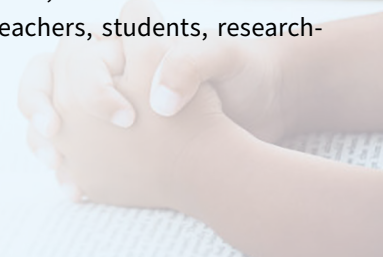
