# Miracles Happen – They really, really do!

lmost 5 years ago, before the global pandemic, sixteen A people from LLP went to a healing conference. The Ignite Conference was hosted by Christian Healing Ministries (CHM) in Vermont and offered healing, encouragement, and connection to all who attended. At that 2019 conference, CHM, based in Florida, announced that this conference would be their last one in New England. Folks were very disappointed because this conference offered so much healing. Nine months later, Covid shut down everything in early 2020.

This global trauma added even greater needs for the healing that only God can provide. Following God's Spirit, LLP moved on line during the shutdown and became amazed at how God continued His work even when we were not physically gathered. LLP connected with so many amazing people all over the country (and in a few different countries!) and continued to offer healing, encouragement, and connection. As the world began to heal and folks began to gather, the desire for Christian conferences re-surfaced.

In January 2023, our foundation felt Jesus calling us to host a healing conference with anointed speakers, worship, personal ministry, and a special-guest worship leader, Julie True. During the prayerful visioning meeting, Holy Spirit revealed seven things...

- Offer a space full of God's goodness to retreat from daily responsibilities
- Tell them I love them and within the rich love of Christ is shelter, simplicity, goodness, peace, laughter
- Under the waterfall of Holy Spirit, we can hear God's voice; find real connection with people and with God

Do you need healing? Do you need to forgive yourself or someone who hurt you? Do you need to hear from Jesus? Want your miracle?

Immerse yourself in His love at the June healing conference.

**Testimony** 

I received a very unexpected miracle in one of LLP's healing prayer sessions.

I lived life "tired", and I don't just mean I simply didn't get enough sleep. As a small child, I was exhausted. My mom would say I would fall asleep eating dinner at the kitchen table. I was always ready for bed. In high school, I was ready for bed at 4:00 PM. It was very hard to function that tired. I felt like I had a lower quality of life.

Neurologists, natural doctors, and the efforts of my mom were unsuccessful as no one could really tell me why I was like this. Because I home-school my kids, a nap was built into the day. I had to find something the kids could do while I took my afterlunch nap because I couldn't function unless I napped every few hours. I felt like it was stealing from me, stealing my life because I constantly needed to be in my bed. To say that I was "tired of being tired" was an understatement.

I came to the healing ministry here at LLP not really expecting anything, but being expectant of whatever God wanted to do and I expected to go home after the prayer ministry and take a napand I didn't! I have not taken any naps in over a month! I'm not tired although I still feel tired when it's appropriate to feel tired. It feels like, 'Oh my gosh, is this is this like normal people feel?'

I can see in hindsight the steps that God took me through to find this ministry and His miracle-working power to me has been extremely evident in the ways I have been able to experience Him more profoundly and clearly. It's miraculous and I'm so grateful to God and I just want to give Him the glory!

### **A Searching and Fearless Moral Inventory**

LLP bumped into Destiny outside <u>Solid Ground Recovery</u> as we arrived to do our program "**Step Work with Emotional Healing**". The meeting was another poignant display of Jesus' healing love as eight ladies from Solid Ground Recovery worked on Step 4 with LLP's recovery ministry team.

Step 4 is a difficult one. Part of a 12-step recovery program, this step encourages one to make a "searching and fearless moral inventory" of themselves. This involves identifying personal habits and getting clear on how our behavior has affected ourselves and others around us. It is a challenging, soul-searching step. LLP's recovery team brings God's mercy, goodness, and the healing love of Jesus to help ladies in this step. The meeting was full of honesty – tears – prayers – Jesus.

## LLP's Continuing Education



Jacqueline Demarest shares her love for Jesus by helping folks with PTSD and sharing her education and experience.

Hope radiates out of licensed counselor *Jacqueline Demarest* as she reviewed Post-traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) for LLP's continuing education zoom meeting. She knows there is life after PTSD and folks who get the help they need, and do the hard work of recovery, find freedom.

Jacqueline defined trauma and noted differences in big 'T' trauma and little 't' trauma. She said we all encounter at least little 't' trauma in our lifetime (a global pandemic). Using excellent examples, she went on to explain key points on how trauma affects lives and what it is like to struggle with severe PTSD symptoms. LLP prayer ministers gained insight into this disorder and, during prayer, how the healing love of Jesus can move into lives affected by trauma.
