Testimony

In 89 years of living, I have had lots of challenges, but this Spring was especially difficult. In April, my husband's health declined after he broke his leg. A few weeks later, I broke my pelvis in 2 places. A few weeks after that, I sustained 2 strokes. Rehabilitation began, but I struggled with the seemingly slow pace of recovery. Although the nurses and therapists were wonderful, my impatience brought on daily frustration and negative thoughts. Listen Love Pray Foundation was offering "Switch on your Brain" and I thought that it might help. Thankfully, the class was on Zoom, so I could attend even from out of state.

God began to work on me. The 5- to 15-minute meditations turned into 30 minutes, and they became the turning point where God was able to step into my busy schedule and change my heart. I realized that I should never be too busy to exclude Jesus. He is the way and the truth. The nursing and rehab staff reported remarkable progress after this breakthrough, and in just 2 weeks, I had met all their goals for transitioning back home. But most exciting of all, I am a new person—my whole heart has changed—it is phenomenal—and that has led to progress in every part of my life. Praise God and thank you LLP for this amazing class.

I couldn't fix my life on my own; it just wasn't working. The Healing Presence of Jesus

When people meet Jesus in prayer, AWE-some happens. Prayer recipients are routinely in AWE of the indescribable love they experience. Jesus always brings exactly what is needed—love, peace that transcends understanding, a vision, the perfect music, a feeling, a scripture, conviction over sin, the right words, tears, healing and unspeakable joy. Tandi talked about sun-bathing as son-bathing, basking in the presence of the unspeakable AWE-some that is Jesus.

Bringing a prayer recipient into the presence of Jesus, is critical. It is Jesus who heals. When Jesus is present, the atmosphere changes. Often the prayer ministers or the prayer recipient can see, hear or feel His presence—tears flow and healing begins. Holy Spirit is a spotlight for Jesus, and He is a gentleman; invite Holy Spirit to come and show the prayer recipient Jesus. Ask prayer recipients what Jesus is doing or saying, and always assure them Jesus is with us. (Mat. 18:20) Listen, Jesus stands at the door and knocks. (Rev. 3:20) Invite Him in!

Conception to Birth Prayer

Lee Ann notes that scripture indicates life begins at conception, and that every life is precious and intended by God. The announcement of life (a pregnancy) should always be a great sign of joy. Unfortunately, we see countless unwanted pregnancies with no joy surrounding the announcement. We also know from scripture that, from conception to death, God is with us, so it only makes sense to start our prayers for inner healing by going back to conception. This effective and remarkable prayer introduces inner healing at a deeper level of memory. As led, she encourages prayer ministers to bring prayer recipients back to their beginning, in the womb, with God.
