





# IMPACT THROUGHOUT THE YEARS



(May 2023) - \$1000 Scholarship awarded. 104 mentees through partnership with existing non-profits and community organizations. (2022-2023 Overview) - Over 200 leaders participated leadership development. 22 Students participated in Leadership Development trainings.

(Nov - Dec 2022) - 50 families received Thanksgiving Giveaway.
180 children in 8 schools received holiday gifts. 10 families participated in feed a family during the holidays.

(Feb 2023) - 200 leaders participated in the Black Leadership Summit themed:

Unlocking Your Potential.

(2020-2021) \$600- Received \$500 PNC Grant and \$100 donation. Received 501(c)3 designation (*March* 2020), created a website, attended 3 leadership trainings.

(2022) - 25 students participated in the first time Youth Entrepreneurship Summit. 78 students participated in the Candid Conversations: With Students For Students Edition a zoom call for middle and high students talk about challenges in school.



A total of 22 high school students participated in leadership development training across three high schools, enhancing their leadership skills and preparing them for future success.

Organized a bike giveaway event with the Pierre Garcon Helping Hands Foundation at five elementary schools, distributing bicycles to 100 children in underserved communities.

Hosted the Black Leadership Summit, a gathering of 200 leaders from across Palm Beach, Broward, Miami Dade and out of state, providing a platform for dialogue, collaboration and empowerment.


#### Data Driven Making & Impact Measurement


#### Leadership Development and Governance Subcommittee (LDGS)


