MAY 5TH CINCO DE MAYO

Cinco de Mayo, Spanish for "Fifth of May," is an annual celebration held on May 5. The date is observed to commemorate the Mexican Army's victory over the French Empire at the Battle of Puebla, on May 5, 1862, under the leadership of General Ignacio Zaragoza.

In the United States, Cinco de Mayo has taken on a significance far beyond that in Mexico. More popularly celebrated in the United States than Mexico, the date has become associated with the celebration of Mexican-American culture. In Mexico, the commemoration of the battle continues to be mostly ceremonial, such as through military parades or battle reenactments.

Cinco de Mayo is sometimes mistaken for Mexico's Independence Day, the most important national holiday in Mexico, which is actually celebrated on September 16, commemorating the Cry of Dolores that initiated the war of Mexican independence from Spain.

MAY 12TH MOTHER'S DAY

Buona Festa della Mamma!

In Italy, *la mamma* is the cornerstone of the home and celebrated by her family, all year round. Still, every second Sunday of May, we *bambini* and *mammoni* jump to lavish our mothers with flowers, gifts, and poems for *La Festa della Mamma*.

Mother's Day was first celebrated in Italy in May 1957, about 50 years after it was founded in the United States. A parish priest began the tradition in Assisi, a beautiful hillside town in Umbria, with great festivities. Many in the surrounding cities got word and joined the appreciation of the women whose unconditional love and hard work helped them become who they are. The day was so successful that just one year later, the holiday was adopted across Italy's 20 regions.

Today, Mother's Day is more widely celebrated than ever. Young or old, children strive to visit their family home in time for *La Festa della Mamma*. As more of us move further away, though, Italians send gifts and make long-distance calls. In fact, urban legend has it that our phone companies record their highest volume of calls on Mother's Day.

But, beyond cards, we value quality time, whether we send our *madre* something that we know will augment her daily life, or we're able enjoy a meal with her.

If you're lucky enough to still have your mother around, don't forget, Mother's Day is Sunday, May 12th.

MAY 27TH MEMORIAL DAY

Armed Forces Day this year falls on Saturday, 18 May. Armed Forces Day honors all members of the military currently serving in the Armed Forces.

Memorial Day this year falls on Monday, 27 May. Memorial Day honors members of the military who died while serving in the Armed Forces. The holiday, which is currently observed every year on the last Monday of May, was previously observed on May 30 from 1868 to 1970.

Veterans Day this year falls on Monday, 11 November. The WW-I Armistice with Germany went into effect on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month in 1918. <u>Veterans Day honors all military veterans</u>.

MAY HOLIDAYS IN ITALY

May Day, May 1, is a public holiday all over Italy as the day of the worker. Many services will be closed but you may find interesting parades and festivals to celebrate the day.

Giro d'Italia, Italy's big bike race similar to the Tour d'France, starts in early May and lasts most of the month.

Night of Museums is held on a Saturday in mid-May. Museums in many Italian cities are open late, often with free admission and special events.

Cantine Aperte, open cantinas, is a big wine celebration throughout Italy the last weekend of May. Many cantine or wineries are open to quests and have special events.

DID YOU KNOW?

Lo sapevate?

On May 16, 1884, Angelo Moriondo of Turin was granted a patent for "New Steam Machinery for the Economic and Instantaneous Confection of Coffee," marking the birth of another Italian icon, the espresso machine. Coffee was extremely popular in the nineteenth century but it took a while to brew. People were eager to reduce the brewing time, and Moriondo's design was the first important step in that direction. However, his machines were bulky and produced coffee only in large quantities. Luigi Bezzerra improved on the design, creating a single-shot espresso maker in 1903. His patent was then bought by Desiderio Pavoni, who made further improvements, and at the 1906 Milan Fair, the two men together the Ideale, a single shot espresso maker, which poured coffee directly into the cup. After the fair, the machines began to appear all over Italy. It was Pavoni who coined the term espresso, highlighting the fact that coffee could be brewed in an instant. Note that espresso refers to the method of preparing coffee, not the roast or type of bean.

ALSO DID YOU KNOW?

Niccolo Machiavelli was born on 3 May 1469 in Florence, Italy. One of the world's most influential political thinkers. Machiavelli served as a chancellor of the Florentine Republic during the time of the Medicis' exile. Thanks to his post, he traveled throughout Europe on diplomatic missions for more than a decade, acquiring a unique insight into the political workings of various regimes and rulers. When the Medicis returned to power, they saw Machiavelli as a threat, and he was jailed and exiled. It was during this time that he wrote his masterpiece, The Prince, in which he advocates a rise to power by any means necessary. Many believe that Machiavelli's Prince, a cunning and ruthless leader, is based on the notorious Cesare Borgia. Whether intended as a satire or a political handbook, The Prince has left an indelible mark on human history. which has seen numerous Machiavellian leaders.
