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5 Steps to Building Your Personal Transportation Plan

1 Identify your transportation needs

Include essential trips such as medical appointments, grocery shopping and other trips such as the salon or barber shop, religious services, work or to visit friends.

How Can LeeTran Assist You?

The Human Service Mobility Coordinator position is a coordinated effort between LeeTran and Human and Veteran Services to work with local families and individuals. The Mobility Coordinator helps individuals gain a greater sense of independence and educates them on how to utilize LeeTran's services in the most efficient manner possible.

The Human Services Mobility Coordinator provides the following services:

- Works with local municipalities and community based employers to increase awareness of fixed route transportation routes and related programs
- Provides guidance and information to neighborhoods and communities relating to transportation and program eligibility
- Coordinates resources with other local agencies to promote client self-sufficiency and well-being
- Provides limited case management services and referrals to assist participant regarding human service related needs
- Determines eligibility of applicants referred to Passport service through community and neighborhood outreach
