## Meltdown is an Arts Happening

One of the highlights of Sunday's Antic will be the "Antic Meltdown," a major large-scale outdoor arts happening conceived and coordinated by composer Rick Russo and actress/playwright Bronwyn Rucker. This unique multi-arts event, the first of its kind both for the Antic and for Brooklyn, will take place from 1 to 5pm along Atlantic Avenue, from Hicks Street to the Brooklyn-Queens Expressway (BQE) over-pass.

This day long avant-garde arts marathon will comprise a simultaneous "arts-mix" merging an array of over one-hundred artists in diverse yet aesthetically complimentary roles. Various forms of conventional and experimental music, electronic media, theatrical events, mixed-media, modern dance, performance-art, poetry readings, fashions and costumes, workshops and visual occurances are part of the activities slated. In addition, a visual kinetic 'set-design,' consisting of various mobiles, colorful banners, experimental kites, balloons and more will add a special festive flavor to this bizarre, unprecedented arts spectacle.

The "Antic Meltdown" is being presented by Meltdown Performing Arts, a newlyformed non-profit organization devoted to the advancement of new, innovative and experimental art forms throughout Brooklyn, and is made possible with the assistance of the Brooklyn Arts and Culture Association, Inc.
