Thank you for your purchase of admission to our drive-in movie concert event, "Lift Every Voice & Sing." It will be an inspiring and uplifting evening, made all the more special by your presence. Attached are more details on directions and parking. Below are some additional points to help your evening go smoothly:

Arrival Time: The movie begins at 8 PM. We will be ready to welcome your car for parking starting at 6 PM. If you wish to arrive earlier to shop or dine, please park elsewhere on the property and then move your vehicle to the movie viewing area any time after 6 PM.

Admission: Enclosed you will find a hang tag for each car in your order. You must have these prominently displayed on your interior rearview mirror to be admitted.

Parking: There are two areas for parking - VIP and General. Parking is on a first-come, first-served basis in each section, so we encourage you to arrive early. If you drive a truck, SUV or other tall vehicle, please park toward the back of the lot.

Hatchbacks: If you have an SUV, we request that you do not pull into a space backwards and open the hatch. This blocks the screen for those behind you.

Safety: This event is safest when viewed from inside your vehicle without walking around and visiting. We ask that you stay in your cars unless you are using the restroom or visiting businesses at Dania Pointe. Please observe the current CDC safety guidelines to ensure that everyone has a safe evening.

Sound: Audio for the event comes from an FM radio transmitter. Instructions will be projected.

Children: If you are bringing children with you, please be mindful of the experiences of others and do not allow them to run around and disrupt the event.

Restrooms: Facilities are located on the other side of the parking deck at the foot of the escalator outside of Bowlero, the bowling alley.

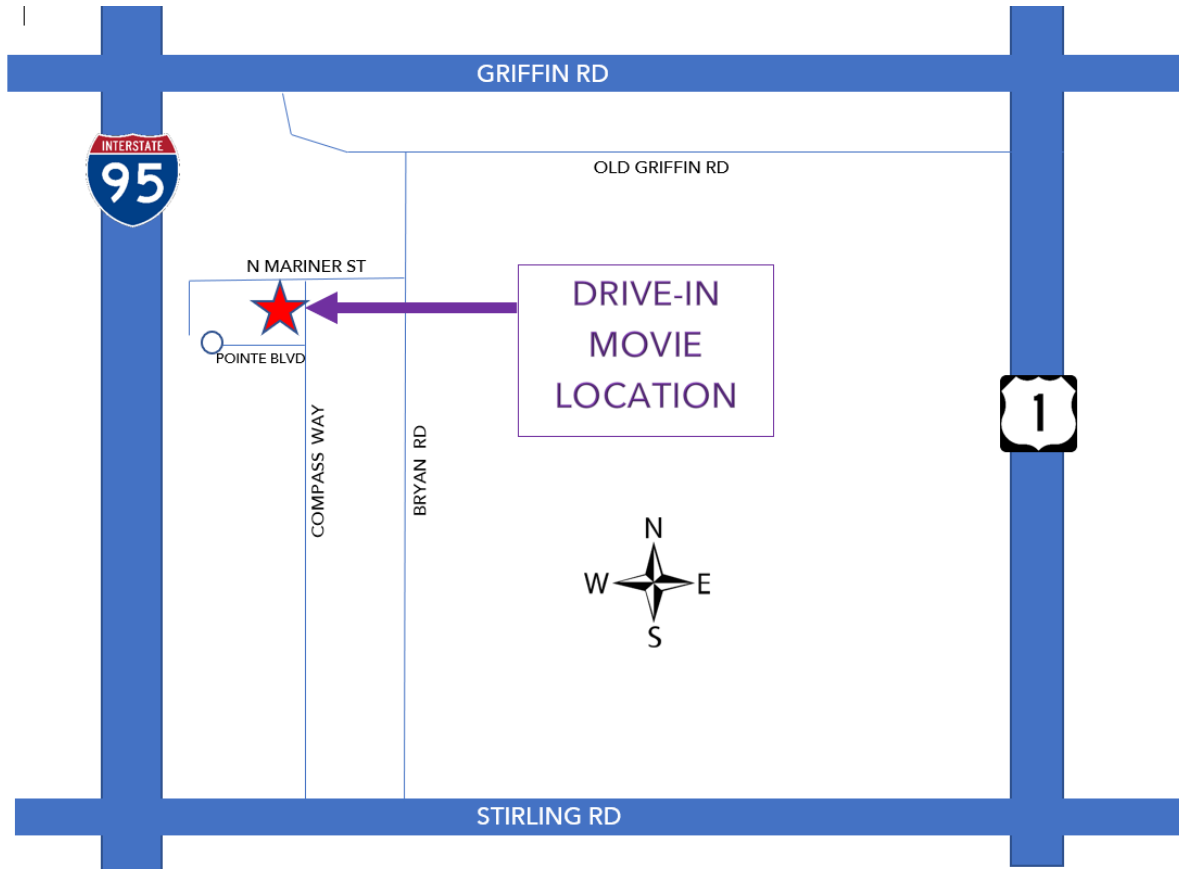

From I-95:

- Exit Stirling Rd (FL 848)
- Head EAST on Stirling Rd until you reach N COMPASS WAY
- TURN LEFT (NORTH) on N COMPASS WAY and travel to POINTE BLVD
- The drive-in lot is ON THE LEFT next to the parking garage. Look for the screen in the grassy lot on the corner of Pointe Blvd and Compass Way.
- You will see traffic attendants to guide you to the event

From US 1:

- Take US1 to OLD GRIFFIN RD
- Head WEST on OLD GRIFFIN RD until you reach N BRYAN RD
- Turn LEFT (SOUTH) on N BRYAN RD and travel to N MARINER ST
- Turn RIGHT onto N MARINER ST and travel to N COMPASS WAY
- Turn LEFT onto N COMPASS WAY
- The drive-in lot is ON THE RIGHT, next to the parking garage. Look for the screen in the grassy lot on the corner of Pointe Blvd and Compass Way.
- You will see traffic attendants to guide you to the event

From the Plaza / Pointe Blvd:

- From the fountain by Tommy Bahama, go EAST on POINT BLVD to the intersection with COMPASS WAY
- The drive-in lot is ON THE LEFT, next to the parking garage. Look for the screen in the grassy lot on the corner of Pointe Blvd and Compass Way
- You will see traffic attendants to guide you to the event

ADMISSION

Before you arrive at the event, please display your hang tag on your rear-view mirror so that it can be plainly seen. You cannot be admitted without your hang tag. It is your official ticket for the event.



IMPORTANT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR OUR DRIVE-IN MOVIE EVENT

We are happy to present a drive-in movie concert so that our fans can get out of the house to enjoy a larger-than-life experience with others. We are committed to doing what we can to try and make the experience as safe as we can for all involved. To do this, we will be enforcing the following requirements for patrons:

- The event will be an in-car experience only. Regrettably, we cannot allow you to bring chairs and sit outside of your vehicle.
- If you emerge from your vehicle to go to the restroom or visit a business at Dania Pointe, masks must be worn at all times when you are in the movie event. Dania Pointe's restaurants and other businesses will enforce their own guidelines.
- If you are in a convertible or wish to roll down windows, you must wear a mask or park so that you are socially distanced from others.
- We will not be permitting patrons to get out of their cars and visit others in their vehicles. If you must communicate with friends who are attending, we suggest using your phone to call and/or text.
- Until more is known, these guidelines are even applicable to guests who are fully vaccinated.

If you are unable to follow the guidelines above, please do not attend the live event and instead join the virtual concert on the 17th.

We respect everyone's rights and freedom; however we also are committed to following established safety protocols to help ensure that one person's freedom of rights does not result in another's loss of life. At our drive-in event, we will have security on hand to help us enforce these policies.
