***Date Change for Mother's Day Brunch:** The parish office (Fr. Lewis) made a mistake when scheduling the Mother's Day Brunch. The brunch will now be on Pentecost Sunday, May 19, followed by the Kneeling Vespers on the Day of the Holy Spirit. Alexandra Katakalides will be planning the event.

PRAYER CHANGE DURING PASCHAL SEASON: During the Pascal season—Pascha until Pentecost—we omit the prayers “Glory to You, Our God...” and the prayer to the Holy Spirit, “Heavenly King, Comforter...” in our usual prayers, and instead, we pray the Paschal Troparia “Christ is Risen...” 3 times, until Ascension. We will resume praying “Heavenly King...” at Pentecost Vespers. Also, during this time, we do not kneel to pray, regardless of the day, but we **stand** for all of our personal prayers.
