



HOW TO...

Make a Template for Seat Cushions on Curved Pews

Picture ① shows a curved pew. Since any change in size up to 1/8" changes the radius on a curved pew, each pew seat needs to have a separate template made.

A large sheet of paper is put down covering each seat from end to end as well as the back edge. The front edge is not needed.②

Next, make creases along these edges. Now cut along each crease.③

Picture ④ shows the paper template with a correct cut in the back and at each end. The paper must be flush with the back edge to get the correct curve.

Picture ⑤ shows the final result once we have made your new Atwood-Hamlin Curved Pew Cushions and they are installed.
