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## RM Peer Group Supervision

Being a Registered Manager carries a lot of responsibilities, at times you must feel overwhelmed, and feel isolated in the role. Having “protected time” even for a short time is helpful to pause, to reflect. Would you like the opportunity to do this with others who are in the same role? This includes some peer support, a chance to network, and a time to share good practice or challenges of this demanding and important role. I have decided to set up this “peer group supervision” to challenge you, to become a “critical friend” and to enable you to slow down just for an hour and use this time to learn, develop and share, a learning exchange.

- The art of working in a preventative way and being less crisis-led - the calm this brings
- Remaining safe, compliant, risk sensible
- Evidencing how you are a learning organisation, sharing themes and patterns and learning from others
