

Policarpo Sanchez Evangelista was laid to rest in Mexico.







Policarpo Sanchez Evangelista was born on January 26, 1969 in in Morelos, Mexico to parents Martin and Isabel. He was the third of seven children.

In his youth, Policarpo enjoyed being outdoors—swimming in the river, climbing trees, and playing with his siblings.

He was an American businessman, political activist, and conspiracy theorist. Lindell is the founder and CEO of My Pillow, Inc., a pillow, bedding, and slipper manufacturing company, and the factory, where Policaarpo worked, is in Shakopee.

In the late 1990s and early 2000s, the major crime problem was kidnapping for ransom.
