

ACLS Precourse Self-Assessment and Precourse Work

The **ACLS Precourse Self-Assessment** is an online tool that evaluates a student's knowledge before the course to evaluate their proficiency and determine the need for additional review and practice in 3 sections: rhythm recognition, pharmacology, and practical application. The student must complete the Precourse Self-Assessment and achieve a score of at least 70% before taking the ACLS Course. The student must print their successful completion certificate and bring it with them to class.

The **ACLS Precourse Work** involves a student reviewing course content through online videos before entering the classroom. The video lessons cover multiple medical subjects and each lesson includes questions to engage the student. This precourse work allows more classroom time for hands-on skills training and leads to the student being better prepared to participate as soon as they enter the classroom.

You must take both of those prior to coming to coming in.

This will take you 4 hours (but you get out earlier and it's not a 2 day class)
