Hong Kong GDP expected to grow 4%

Hong Kong's economy would grow 4% this year, Chinese Manufacturers' Association of Hong Kong President Dr Allen Shi predicted at the body's Annual General Meeting yesterday, Sing Tao reported.

The outlook for Hong Kong's export trade was hardly optimistic but domestic demand would stabilise the economy. Hong Kong's economy would continue to slowly improve in the second half. Moderate growth of 3.5% was expected for next year.

Hong Kong holds Global Financial Centres Index spot

Hong Kong maintained its No.4 spot in the Global Financial Centres Index (GFCI) 34 Report published yesterday by the Z/Yen from the United Kingdom and the China Development Institute from Shenzhen, HKEJ reported.

A government spokesman said: "Hong Kong's overall rating increased notably, with the global rankings in the four areas of business environment, human capital, financial sector development and reputational and general having risen to fourth, reflecting recognition of Hong Kong's sustained strength and robustness as an international financial centre in the post-COVID era.

New York has remained the world's top financial centre with London second and Singapore third.





Hong Kong capitalises on GBA strengths

The advantages of One Country, Two Systems meant Hong Kong was the only city that combined the strengths of China with those of the rest of the world, Mr Lee said Hong Kong was one of the world's leading international financial centres and was well-positioned to play an even greater role in the financial sector in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area and contribute to high-quality GBA development.

Speaking at the Phoenix Financial Forum for the GBA yesterday, Mr Lee said Hong Kong was Asia's green finance hub. The city would continue to enhance competitiveness in this regard and looked forward to more organisations in the GBA using Hong Kong's green finance market.

The Shenzhen-Hong Kong-Guangzhou science and technology cluster has ranked second globally for four consecutive years in the Global Innovation Index 2023 published by the World Intellectual Property Organization, Hong Kong Commercial Daily reported.

Hong Kong's ranking remains fifth in Asia and 17th globally among 132 economies



Belt and Road Summit

Reaching its 10th anniversary of the Belt and Road Initiative, the 2023 edition of the Summit featured 99 heavyweight speakers and gathered over 5,800 project owners, investors, contractors, infrastructure and engineering consultants, architectural companies, design, and services providers from more than 70 countries and regions.

Over 800 one-to-one business matching meetings involving over 280 projects were arranged during the event. South African attendees included the JCCI, Wesgro and Nick Ferguson presented the Cape Winelands Aero airport project to potential investors.
