The good news is that this has been acknowledged by TPT, who issued a communique on Wednesday relative to this — we acknowledge and appreciate their undertaking in resolving the current issues.

As EWC has always stated 'We are better together' and must work in co-operation and collaboration.

The IMF in their quarterly review stated that growth in SA is currently at 0.03%, however if we could get our logistics supply chain back on track, the growth factor can increase to $2\frac{1}{2}$ - 3%.






