## **HOW THE NOMINATION PROCESS WORKS**

- YOU ARE A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING This means you have registered as a member and donated \$100 in the previous quarter.
- YOU SUBMIT A NOMINATION
   You fill out the MEMBER section of the Nomination Form (found on our website) and have your NONPROFIT fill out their section.

   You submit it to the contact listed on the form at least 5 days before the next meeting.
- WE VERIFY THE CHARITY'S TAX STATUS We search their Tax ID number in federal and state databases.
- YOU COMMUNICATE WITH THE CHARITY If you would like a representative to attend our meeting and potentially give a presentation, please invite them.
- YOU MUST BE PRESENT AT THE MEETING If your nomination is one of three drawn from the hat, you must be present even if someone else gives your "pitch."
- IF YOUR NOMINATION IS NOT DRAWN It will remain in the hat for subsequent meetings unless/until you ask us to remove it.
- IF IT IS DRAWN BUT DOES NOT WIN

  meetings unless/until you ask us to remove it.
- IF YOUR NOMINATION WINS
   It will be removed from the hat and be ineligible for 2 years. At any point after that you may nominate them again if you would like to. Also, please invite the charity to send a representative to our NEXT meeting to update us on how our donations have been put to work.
- WE WILL DELIVER THE CHECKS
   and online donation receipts to come in. Then we schedule a time to deliver them and take a photo for Facebook. All members are welcome to attend.
- TIMELY PAYMENTS MAY BE MATCHED
   Winners may be eligible to receive a 50%
   match from the Richard M. Schulze Family Foundation, but we have only 4 weeks from our
