## JUNE GAME DESCRIPTIONS

### Ribbon Rainbow Game (Low Net Score)

- Each captain will receive four colored ribbons to distribute randomly to your team (one per person)
- Play a regular game of golf. Each whiff counts as one stroke.
- The player whose ribbon corresponds to the ribbon tied to the bottom of the flag-stick will be the team score.
- Two scores will be recorded: 1) each player's actual score for 9 holes including putts and 2) the team score based on the color of the ribbon.
- Record birdies and chip-ins in appropriate columns (Do not circle holes)
- IN CASE OF THREE PLAYERS use the truncated average of three players' scores for the fourth player's score.
- For prizes— awarded for low team score.
- GIMMIES AND MULLIGANS ALLOWED

### 4 Person Scramble

- All players tee off from the GOLD tees. Any tee shots made from the orange tee results in team disqualification. NO GIMMIES OR MULLIGANS, MUST PUTT OUT.
- Pick the best drive. Player whose drive is used does not hit the second shot.
- Use each players drive twice in 8 holes. On the 9th hole use the best drive.
- Players whose drives have been used twice WILL NOT DRIVE on subsequent holes.
- All players hit from 3rd shot until ball is holed.
- Record total score and number of putts..
- No birdies or chip-ins awarded.
- For prizes: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place teams.
- When three people are playing, the rule is modified so that each player's drive is used three times, and all three players may hit the second ball. On the green, play as a 4 -person team, rotating people for the 4th putt on each hole.

### Low Individual Score-Putts

- Play a regular game of golf. Each whiff counts as one stroke.
- Record each player's strokes and putts for every hole.
- Record birdies and chip-ins in appropriate columns (DO NOT circle holes).
- Record each player's total score and total putts.
- For prizes-awarded to individuals with lowest total putts.
- NO GIMMIES OR MULLIGANS, MUST PUTT OUT.

### Par 3 from Red Tees

- Play a regular game of golf. Each whiff counts as one stroke.
- Record each player's strokes and putts for every hole.
- Record birdies and chip-ins in appropriate columns (DO NOT circle holes).
- For prizes-awarded to individual with low score
- MULLIGANS AND GIMMIES ALLOWED.

## PACE OF PLAY

### Ladies, A gentle reminder!!

Coronado Golf Course, 9 holes, should ideally be played in **two hours**. This is our goal!! Currently it is taking us closer to three hours. Suggestions for faster play include:

- Take **ONE** practice swing.
- **Play Ready Golf!** Between tee off to green, players should be ready to hit their ball, whether they are away (farther out from other players) or not.
- When a lost ball is NOT found after looking for no more than **two minutes**, the player drops another ball near the point it went out (no closer to the hole). Take one stroke penalty.
- When carts are restricted to the path, players should carry three clubs to the ball: the one they believe to be the best one, one above and one below.
- Carry extra tees, balls and markers at all time during play.
- Move to the next tee box before announcing/recording scores.

## A Few Lady Duffer Golf Guidelines

- Keep carts AT LEAST 10 yards from greens.
- No talking or moving while others are playing a stroke.
- Duffers do not teach golf to others during a round.
- Marking the ball: Always place marker BEHIND the ball. If your ball is in the putting line of another player, use your putter head to mark to the side and replace your ball at your original lie.
- Bare Rock: If the player elects to take a relief, she shall find the closest point of relief at least ONE club length, no closer to the hole, and drop the ball WITHOUT penalty.
- Ball in Water: If the player goes in the water she shall under penalty of one stroke, drop a ball no closer to the hole within TWO club lengths of where the ball last crosses the margin of the hazard.
- Out of Bounds: Determine where the ball last crossed the out-of-bounds marker and under the penalty of one stroke, drop a ball no nearer the hole within TWO club lengths of that spot.
- Hitting Another Player's Ball on the Green: Two penalty strokes are incurred if a player already on the green putts her ball and hits another player's ball that is at rest. There is no penalty incurred if a player hitting from off the green hits a player's ball on the green. The player whose ball was hit must replace her ball to original position.
- Playing Another's Ball: If a player plays another person's ball, it is a one stroke penalty. The player whose ball was hit MUST replace her ball on its original position.
