## APRIL GAME DESCRIPTIONS

### Low Individual Score-Net

- Play a regular game of golf. Each whiff counts as one stroke.
- Record each player's strokes and putts for every hole.
- Record birdies and chip-ins in appropriate columns (DO NOT circle holes).
- Record each player's total score and total putts.
- For prizes-awarded to individuals with lowest net score.
- NO GIMMIES OR MULLIGANS, MUST PUTT OUT.

### Low Individual Score-Gross

- Play a regular game of golf. Each whiff counts as one stroke.
- Record each player's strokes and putts for every hole.
- Record birdies and chip-ins in appropriate columns (DO NOT circle holes).
- Record each player's total score and total putts.
- For prizes-awarded to individuals with lowest gross score.
- NO GIMMIES OR MULLIGANS, MUST PUTT OUT.

### Par 3 from Red Tees

- Play a regular game of golf. Each whiff counts as one stroke.
- Record each player's strokes and putts for every hole.
- Record birdies and chip-ins in appropriate columns (DO NOT circle holes).
- For prizes-awarded to individual with low score
- MULLIGANS AND GIMMIES ALLOWED.

### 3 Clubs a Putter

- Select three clubs from your golf bag for play along with your putter. Bring only these four clubs to the first tee box. You will play with these clubs only for all 9 holes.
- Play a regular game of golf. Each whiff counts as one stroke.
- Record each player's strokes and putts for every hole.
- Record birdies and chip-ins in appropriate columns (DO NOT circle holes).
- For prizes-awarded to individual with low score.

### GOLF TERMS (slightly modified by editor)

**Mulligans** –A second shot that is allowed to be taken in friendly play when the player has “muffed” the first one. . Players are given the opportunity to purchase a mulligan for \$1.00. (Only one per game!) Mulligans are allowed only on certain play days

**Gimmies**– A gimmie is a ball that lies 18” or less from the hole, measured from the putter grip-end. If you have a ‘gimmie’ you do not need to ‘putt out’ but must count the shot as if you did. This helps with pace of play not to mention your score. Gimmies are allowed only on certain play days.

**Whiff**– To swing and miss the ball completely. (My personal favorite! No shame.)
