PLAYING READY GOLF

Ladies, Again, a Gentle Reminder!!

Coronado Golf Course, 9 holes, should ideally be played in **under two hours**. This is our goal!! Currently it is taking us closer to three hours. Given the heat we **really** need to play Ready Golf. Suggestions include:

- Take **one** practice swing.
- Between tee off to green, players should be ready to hit their ball, whether they are away (farther out from other players) or not. Even on Par 3's. Most of us know how far we can drive. If there is no way you can hit into the team in front of you, meaning they are all on the green and you can't get within 100 yards, go ahead and Tee off. Have your players who typically hit shorter go first The team in front of you <u>does not</u> have to be off the green. Another scenario is for Par 4's. The team in front of you is still in the fairway but you know you can not hit within 100 yards of them... go ahead and hit your ball, again having players with shorter drives go first.
- When a lost ball is NOT found after looking for no more than **two minutes**, the player drops another ball near the point it went out (no closer to the hole). Take one stroke penalty.
- When carts are restricted to the path, players should carry three clubs to the ball: the one they believe to be the best one, one above and one below.
- Carry extra tees, balls and markers at all time during play.
- Move to the next tee box before announcing/recording scores.
- Enjoy the game! Enjoy one another! Do MOST of your socializing before and after play. We arrive 45 minutes before we tee off—right?! And Caddies is a great place to stay for a bit; have breakfast or lunch, or just hydrate and brag on one another!
