ENGINEER'S REPORT

The following items pertaining to the cost estimate for the public sewage project was discussed.

The current estimate is 15.4 million dollars. The increase is due to the project scope and construction costs.

Phasing the project is an option. Grant funding is available to aid in lowering the monthly cost for customers.

Penn Vest and RUS provide loans for public sewage projects.

The engineer, Rick Barnett, will contact the Township's State Representative and Senator for a meeting with the Authority to discuss support of the project for grant funding.

The archeological study for the location of the sewage plant at Herman Road is completed.

Rick Barnett will contact Chris Ziegler regarding the sewage service line proximity to rails-to-trails.

The Township's Solicitor will be contacted regarding a Developer Agreement for Kozik Lane sewage service line.

ADDITIONAL BUSINESS

Due to costs, the engineer will research scaling back the project to an alternative temporary smaller plant at Brinker Road. The smaller plant will be converted at a later date into a pump station for a larger plant.

OPEN TO THE FLOOR – PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The residents requested the financial feasibility rate. The Act 537 Plan financial feasibility rate is \$74.00 per month.

Vogleyville Road is included in the service area for public sewage.

ADJOURN

With there being no further business to come before the Summit Township Authority, Robert Thompson made a motion to adjourn. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
