2016 Road Projects



The following projects are scheduled.

Berming: Bonniebrook Road, Great Belt Road and Osche Road

Crack Sealing: Shepperd Drive

Drainage: Binsey Road

Re-construction: Old Route 422 East

Seal Coating: Bonniebrook Road, Great Belt Road, Moran Road and Simon Drive

Thank you for your patience and cooperation with these projects. There may be times when you will experience delays and road closures. Also, please be safety conscious of our road crew.

Future Road Projects

McGrady Hollow Road has qualified for the Community Development Block Grant Fund. The residents that participated in the survey last year were a determining factor with receiving the funding. Thank you for your willingness to participate. It will be approximately three years before the work will begin due to the scope of the project.

Bonniebrook Road Grant The township is in the process of applying for a grant to re-pave of Bonniebrook Road from the intersection of Route 422 to the Herman Road intersection. If the grant is received, it will be approximately two years before the work will begin.

Home Improvements

Here are some of the most common projects that require a zoning permit:

1. Decks, porches and additions
2. Carports, garages and sheds
3. Swimming pools

Zoning Permits range from \$35.00 — \$85.00 depending on the project. If you do not obtain a permit, the fee is doubled.

Driveway Improvements

If you are planning to construct a new driveway or alter an existing driveway, a permit is required. It is the property owner's responsibility to obtain the permit. No work is to begin until after the Roadmaster completes a preliminary site inspection to ensure that the driveway meets the township's specifications. The cost of the permit is \$75.00. If a permit is not obtained, the fee is doubled.
