Home Improvement Season



With the arrival of Spring , it is that time of year to plan your home improvement projects. Please contact the Township office at 724-285-1168 for any questions regarding whether your project requires a permit. If a project is started without a permit, the fee is doubled.

The most common projects that require permits are decks, porches, swimming pools, sheds, garages and car ports.

Landscaping

All shrubs, trees, and landscaping items are not allowed on the Township’s right-of-way. Please take into account the full growth of the landscaping so that it does not encroach onto the Township’s right-of-way. If you are unsure of your road’s right-of-way width, contact the Township so your landscaping will not impact the Township’s ability to maintain the road.

Driveways

The installation of a driveway requires a permit. Depending on the scope of a driveway update or improvement, a permit may be required. Please contact the Township’s Roadmaster before you begin so that a determination can be made.

The Township does not want a property owner to have additional expenses for paving their driveway. Instances have occurred when a property owner assumed that the paving company obtained a permit but a permit was not obtained. The driveway failed to meet the Township’s specifications.. It is the property owner’s responsibility to ensure that the driveway meets the Township’s standards. Please be sure a permit is obtained before you begin your project.
