BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF SUMMIT, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

APPROVING THE FAIR HOUSING RESOLUTION for 2019

LET IT BE KNOWN TO ALL PERSONS of the Township of Summit that discrimination in the sale, rental, leasing, financing of housing or land to be used for construction of housing, or in the provision of brokerage services because of race, color, sex, national origin, religion, age, ancestry, familial status (families with children), or handicap (disability) is prohibited by Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Law) and the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act. It is the policy of the Township of Summit to implement programs to ensure equal opportunity in housing for all persons regardless of race, color, religion, age, ancestry, sex, national origin, handicap or disability, or familial status (families with children) or use of guide or support animals because of the blindness, deafness or physical handicap of the user or because the user is a handler or trainer of support or guide animals. Therefore, the Township of Summit does hereby pass the following resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED that, within available resources, the Township of Summit will assist all persons who feel they have been discriminated against because of race, color, religion, age, ancestry, sex, national origin, handicap or disability, or familial status (families with children) or use of guide or support animals because of the blindness, deafness or physical handicap of the user or because the user is a handler or trainer of support or guide animals to seek equity under federal and state laws by filing a complaint with the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Summit Township appoints the Housing Officer of the County of Butler as its designated Housing Officer.
