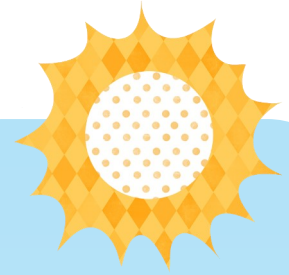

Bonniebrook Road Paving Project

Phase II of the Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant will be the paving of Bonniebrook Road from Route 422 to Route 356.

The project is tentatively scheduled for April through August. Please be advised there will be times of delays and road closures for this project.

Your patience, cooperation and safety for the road crew is very much appreciated.

American Rescue Plan Funding

The Federal Government on March 11, 2021 announced the signing of the federal coronavirus relief package of \$1.9 trillion which is known as the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

Summit Township has been awarded funding. The funding will be disbursed with fifty percent in June 2021 and the remaining fifty percent in 2022. Guidelines to specific uses for the funding has not been determined. Upon the completion of the guidelines, the Township will evaluate options for the funding.

Spring—Summer Projects

If you are planting /landscaping, please keep in mind the full growth of the plants/bushes. Please do not plant them too close to the Township's right-of-way so that road maintenance will negatively impact your landscaping. If you are unsure of your right-of-way distance call the Township at 724-285-1168.

Decks, porches, garages, sheds and swimming pools are a few of the basic items that require a Zoning Permit. If you are planning an outdoor project, call the Township to determine the permitting requirements.

Signs require a Planning Commission review before installation. For your zoning district requirements, please contact the Township.

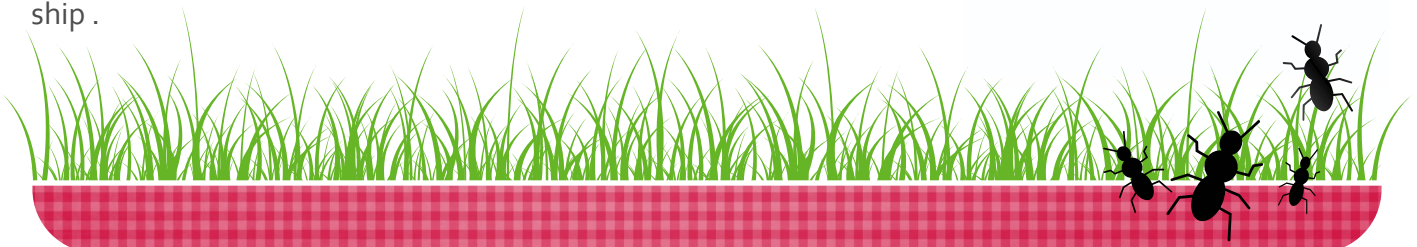

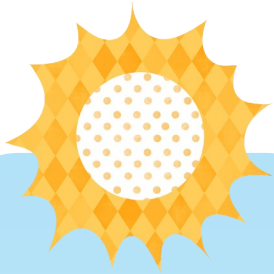
