Informed Consent Script

Do you understand the meaning of informed consent?

Informed consent is the act of agreeing to allow something to happen, or to do something, with a full understanding of all the relevant facts, including risks, and available alternatives. That full knowledge and understanding is the necessary factor in whether an individual can give informed consent. This type of consent applies to many situations in life, including making decisions about medical care and legal issues, as well as entering into contracts.

Consent is given only if that person has been informed of, and understands the facts of the situation., with a full comprehension of the risks and benefits of the decision, as well as an understanding of the possible alternatives, that any individual can consider whether an action would be in his best interests.

Obtaining of informed consent is especially important in the medical field, as failing to receive such approval leaves medical professionals liable for injuries that may occur.

Do you feel as though you have been fair and informative with patients, or otherwise, a customer, before injecting the Covid-19 vaccine into their body? (Wait for their reply, if they say yes, ask them what information they provided and ask them to cite their sources. If they say no, ask them why not, and "are you aware of the legal ramifications of not providing the necessary informed consent information?" {This document explains all of this in further detail.}
