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A NOTE ABOUT SNOW REMOVAL IN SMX

Our recent round of snow certainly wasn't as challenging as what hit the East Coast a couple days later, but the weekend storm still created its share of challenges in SMX.

Our second plow-worthy snowfall was followed by a dusting and then below-freezing temperatures. Therefore any sidewalks that were not cleared soon enough resulted in dangerous ice patches for walkers and kids at bus stops.

Sidewalks in front of your house are your responsibility to keep clear. If we have another snow, please be sure to clear your walks or find a good samaritan neighbor to help you out.

Apologies also to those who live at the ends of cul de sacs. Mailboxes were blocked by our snow removal contractor trying to avoid damaging lawns by pushing too far back. That situation will be avoided next time.

Please remember that the frozen retention ponds near the SMX pool are off limits to sledders and skaters. Avoid parking on the streets during snow storms and don't shovel or blow snow back into the street from your driveway after the plows go through. Note that Silver Stream and Springmill Blvd. are cleared by the city and side streets by SMX contractor Wesley's, after two inches of snow have fallen.



2021 SPRINGMILL CROSSING PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION APPROVED BUDGET

This 2021 operating budget for the Springmill Crossing POA was reviewed, debated, and approved by unanimous vote during the December 1 POA board meeting. This year's major repair and capital projects will include renovation of the 136th St. entrance structures (adding limestone caps and tuck pointing the mortar as was completed at the Spring Mill Rd. entrance in Spring 2020), re-landscaping each entrance, replacing the toilet dividers and re-coating the floors in the pool bathrooms, and planting trees by the pool parking lot. This budget is made possible by your \$500 annual dues.


