POOL IS OPEN AT SPRINGMILL CROSSING

Springmill Crossing pool season officially began on Sunday, May 30, after a chilly start to the season. The pool will remain open daily from 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., until school resumes in August.

Our pool management company will enforce our resident ID tags rule for entrance to the pool this summer. Please be prepared to show your tag to a lifeguard as you enter the pool. If you have lost your tags or are a new resident who wasn't provided tags by your home's seller, please contact Keian Roudebush.

Be sure to review the pool's rules listed under the Pool & Tennis tab at www.springmillcrossing.org. Remember that children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by a guardian of at least 14 years of age.

Food is only permitted in the Strobel Shelter per Hamilton County Health Department rules, and glass containers, alcoholic beverages, and smoking/ vaping are not permitted in or surrounding the pool. Please be safe around the diving board, as well, by following the posted rules.

GET YOUR KEY TO THE TENNIS COURTS

The tennis courts were resurfaced in 2019 and new LED lights were added after a major capital investment by the Springmill Crossing Property Owners Association. Contact our tennis chairman Joon Lee (Lot 19, joonlee95@gmail.com) for a key to enjoy this refurbished amenity (a \$10 deposit is required.) Please be sure to clean up before you leave and lock the gate securely behind you. We are working with an electrician to reconnect the lighting timer, so late-night tennis is unavailable at this time.




