

The pool will remain open daily from 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., until school resumes in August, weather permitting.

Regular pool users will appreciate several updates this season. Following last year's bathroom/shower building roof replacement, interior renovations, and the addition of security cameras, the exterior of the building was resided and painted, bathroom entrance screens replaced with Trex fencing, and trash container corral was stained and resealed.

C&N, our pool management company, will enforce our resident ID tags rule at the pool again this summer, when necessary, so please show your tag to a lifeguard as you enter the pool, if requested.

If you have lost your tags or are a new resident

who wasn't provided tags by your home's seller, then please contact pool chairman Keian Roudebush (keian.roudebush@yahoo.com) to acquire new ones.

Please review the pool's rules listed under the Pool & Tennis tab at www.springmillcrossing. org to make sure you know what is and is not allowed in and around the pool.

We're pleased to welcome back some veteran lifeguards and first-timers to the pool this summer. They are doing a great job keeping the facilities clean and our swimmers safe, but if you see something out of sorts, please be sure to share your concerns with them directly, during an adult swim break. Keep in mind that are our lifeguards are mostly high school and college kids learning their way through a summer job, so every day is a opportunity for them to improve. However, if your issue is not resolved to your satisfaction, please contact a board member or C&N, to handle it.

Also, please bring guests (limited to six per family), but note that you must be in attendance with them.

REMINDERS

NO TRAILERS, BOATS...

In SMX, no boat, RV, or truck (one ton or larger in size) is allowed to be parked overnight or longer on any lot or street in the development, unless it is not visible to the occupants of other lots in the development (such as in a garage), or the users of any street in the development. The same goes for trailers. Please store them elsewhere.
