BOARD OF DIRECTORS

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IT'S BUDGET PLANNING TIME FOR SMX

Discussions will continute on line items for the 2021 budget during the Springmill Crossing Property Owners Association Zoom meeting on November 2. The board will consider input from residents on how funds will be distributed. You may email your suggestions to any board member.

The board will assess the current condition of all neighborhood assets and discuss repair and maintenance needs, as well as any reasonable improvements.

The board is already considering a wish list of items, including new James Hardie siding and

exterior trim painting of the pool pump room and shower building, new Trex-style exterior screens in front of each pool bathroom door, painting two sets of pickleball court lines on one of the current tennis courts and purchasing of two mobile nets to add two optional pickleball courts. (Both current tennis court nets will remain in place during the season and available when pickleball is not being played.)

The final 2021 budget will be approved during the December 7 board meeting.

Annual dues (due January 31) will remain at \$500 per property.

WHAT TO DO ABOUT LAWN FLOODING

It was brought to the attention of the board, via a anonymous letter, that someone's backyard drainage easement is not properly clearing of rainwater, even several days after a storm. To clarify "jurisdiction" for these situations, drainage easement repairs are handled by either the City of Carmel's Engineering Department or the Hamilton County Drainage Board, not the POA Board. Most of us have trouble with backyard flooding. 

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
