THE COVID-19 FAITH

Since the beginning of this so called pandemic with social distancing, mask mandates, toilet paper, beef shortages, peperoni shortages (Tucson AZ) and isolation rule, *The Isaiah Connection* has received many calls and emails on what we are doing to continue building relationships in the communities we serve. There were many sad hearts and concerns from individuals that we could not bring the Gospel message of Christ to those we so love. However, this was not God's intent!

The Isaiah Connection and the Team stepped out in faith and realized that we could still go but in the form of giving and prayer. Thus, we created a COVID-19 page on our website, which features prayer and needs from the communities we have built relationships over the last 19 years.

One such area has been in San Jeronimo Honduras and surrounding areas who have been hit with a food shortage and now a hurricane. To date and with all of your help we have been able to raise over \$15K (note: none of the donations received have gone to the operating budget of *The Isaiah Connection*, all has gone to the field) to help Pastor Olman provide beans and rice to over 1,000 families and since the hurricane hit, to provide beds and basic living supplies to those who lost everything!
