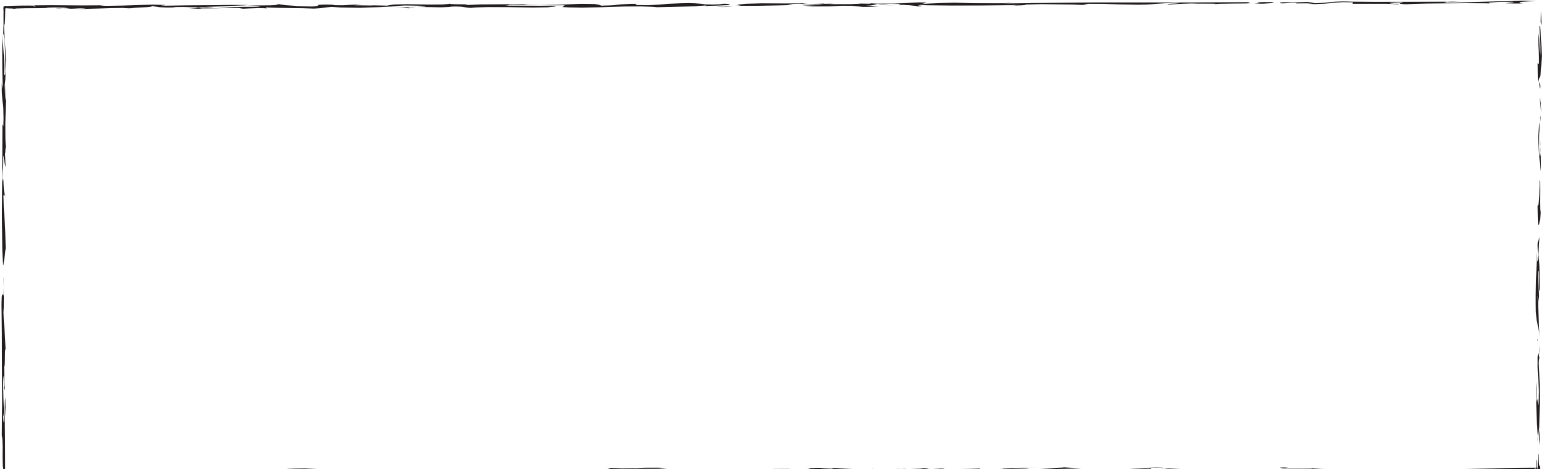


From Farms to Food Pyramid

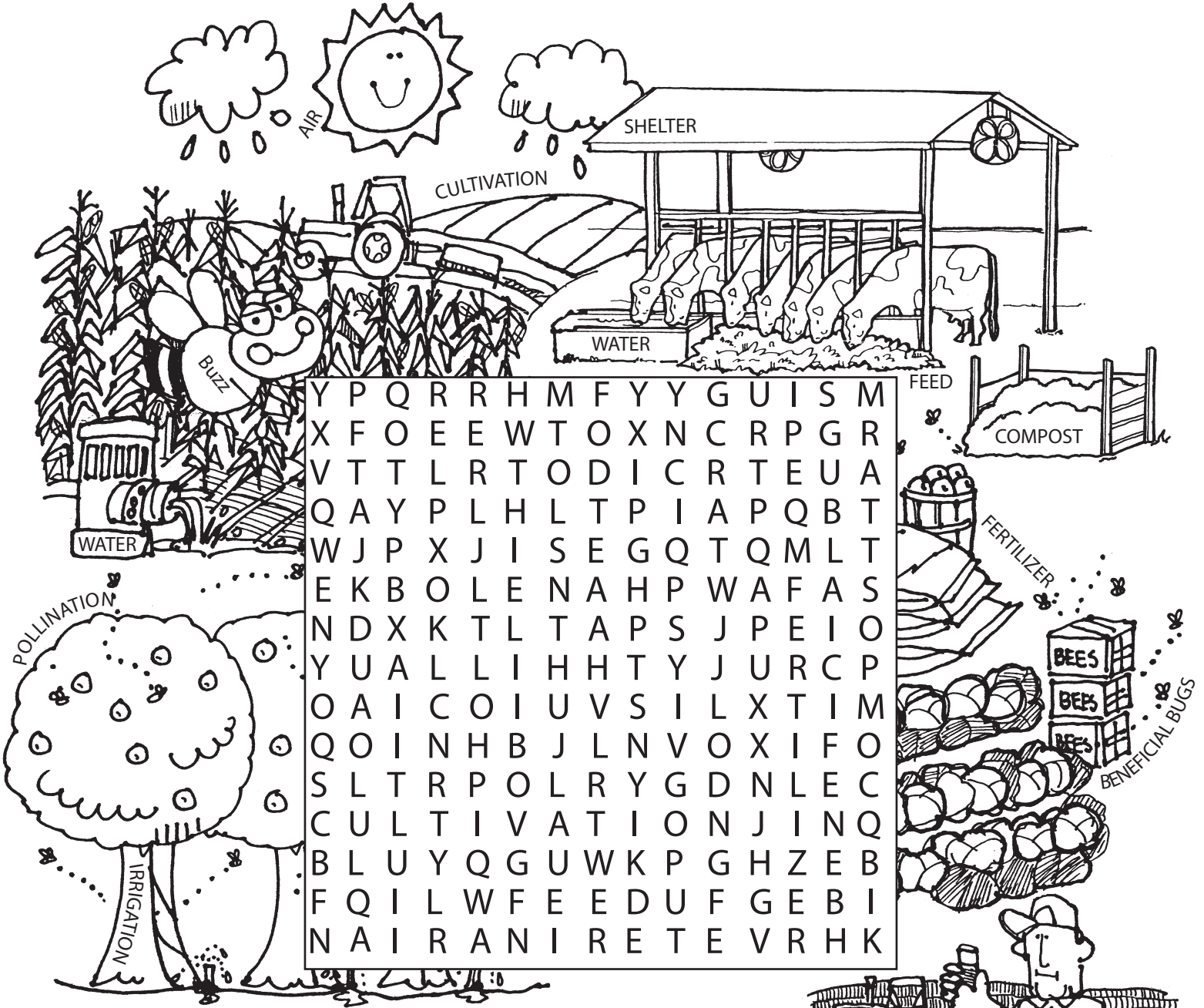

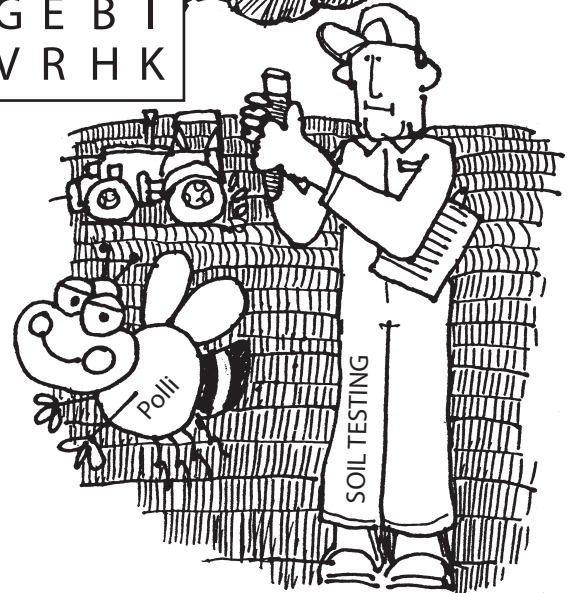
