This is fourth of a seven-part series of the Mealer inconsistencies:

Part 4 – Suddenly, after no demonstrated Republican voting or donating record, the Californian moves to Texas and runs for public office

Background

- We asked Mealer on many occasions to explain her lack of any voting record in Harris County Republican politics
- We asked Ohio's for her voting and donation record
- We asked California for her voting and donation record
- We asked Mealer to simply explain why, after no demonstratable conservative voting and donating record did she decide to run for public office
- Her answer was red faced anger and indignance directed toward us for daring to ask the question
- Next, her campaign and Mealer herself began loudly and regularly complaining that she was being attacked

Since when is it an attack to ask a candidate a simple question?

We have no way of knowing who she really is and what she is showing us is indignance and anger.

We thought she wanted to represent us. We were wrong.

She is showing us that she just wants to get elected and our questions are just bothersome to her.

- 2016 November General Election
- 2020 Republican primary elections
- November general elections in 2016, 2018, and 2020

Defiance County, OH

- Registered to vote in December 2007
- voted in November General Elections in 2012 and 2014
- Refused to disclose who she voted for when asked

Based on her address history, voter history requests were also submitted to:

- Norwell, MA: The Norwell Town Clerk responded to the request was not a registered voter
- Sacramento County, CA is pending awaiting response

Mealer Contribution Record:

- Decides to run for office
- Joins key republican women's and Tea Party Republican group
- Starts donating to fellow west point graduate campaign
- All within 6 months of starting her own campaign for office

A search of Texas Ethics Commission records revealed 6 contributions by Mealer from 2000 through the present, totaling \$530. Her contributions were made to Republican organizations:
