

It will start at the White River Elementary School on Pine Street then proceed straight, across the intersection, over the Lehman Bridge and left onto Railroad Row. Then right across the tracks and left onto South Main Street. From there we turn right onto Gates Street , right onto Church St. then left on North Main Street up to the traffic light and over the Urban Bridge. Finally, right onto Maple Street in front of the Coop and left back to the School. This will provide for a better traffic flow throughout town during the parade.



She met her husband Roland in her junior year at Hartford and married him in 1943 , while he was home on leave from the Army. They later lived in Wilder for many years where they raised two daughters Dee (Aher) and Doreen (Cutter).


