There is much pride associated with being a Hurricane. The athletic department is installing an Alumni Arch as a grand entrance to the newly named Alumni Sports Complex on the HHS campus. Donations have been coming in all year with funds going towards the Arch and the creation of **Legacy Park**, a place where the events, icons and legends of Hartford's past are recognized and celebrated. This will be located on the green space just inside the Arch near the fitness center and the pool fence. With pool renovation slated for this summer this area will soon be a focal point for visitors to our campus and we are excited to share our proud history with everyone.

The first installment will be for our longtime athletic trainer and supporter of all things Hurricane, Luna Ricker. The retiring and then passing of Luna created a significant void in operations at the high school, specifically in the athletic department. Along with her incredible ability to tend to all student's needs Luna was a tremendous collector and curator of Hartford's past. She had a houseful of memorabilia of sports,

theater, graduation and all things in between.

During the quarantine the athletic department has taken on the task of organizing and digitizing much of her collection to create as complete a history of Hartford athletics as there has ever been. Luna's collection along with the work of the late John P. Gates has led to the beginning of this important project and numerous conversations with teachers, coaches and alumni have filled in gaps and will hopefully result in something we can all enjoy as we look back through the proud history of our beloved school.


Thanks to Luna the high school now has every HHS yearbook ever produced with the exception of 1948

Thus far we have found 15 league championships that are not noted anywhere in the school. These teams will be added to the banners in the gym this summer to more accurately reflect our school's history. The Hartford athletics teams enjoyed a banner year in 2020 before the year was cut short. The class of 2020 had already earned 5 league championships and 2 state championships and were well on their way to breaking the 25 year record of 10 banners in 1 school year. (held by 1994). The boys golf team captured the D-11 staté title in October and the girls track team blew the doors off the competition in February to win the first indoor track title in school history.





There is no doubt that the winning ways would have continued with girls lacrosse and girls track and field favored to win state titles in their respective sports this spring. It has been an honor and a privilege to work with these fine studentathletes and their hard-working coaches and we look forward to getting back to work as soon as possible. 2019 2nd Place Float Winner Cheers-Class of 1994


2019 3rd Place Float Winner - Saturday Night Live Class of 1979
