

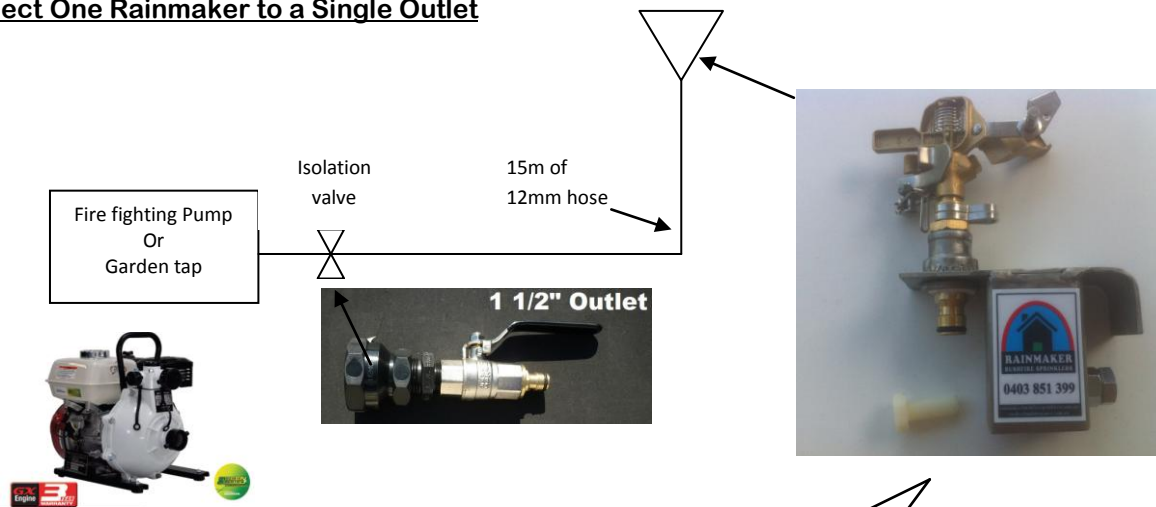
# Protecting your home with the Rainmaker Bushfire Sprinkler®.

Our system is modular; the number of sprinklers you require will depend on the size of your home and your water supply. We believe that two Rainmakers will be sufficient to protect a suburban home, when utilised to defend the side of your home facing the fire front.

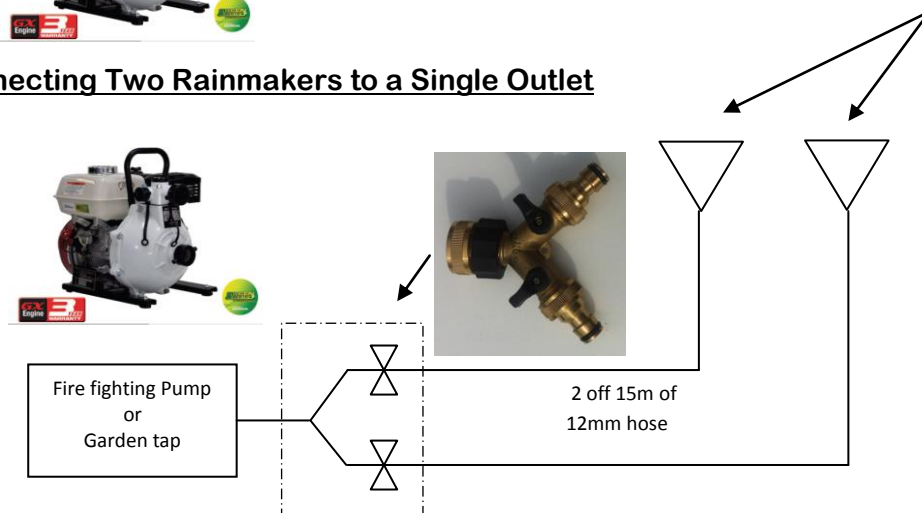
The drawing show the recommended configurations for a single or dual sprinklers, if more sprinklers are required the using a combination of these configurations is recommended.

We recommend 15 Metre Pope Brumby 12mm heavy duty hose as it has a 15 year warranty, the action of the sprinkler will cool and protect the hose.

## Connect One Rainmaker to a Single Outlet

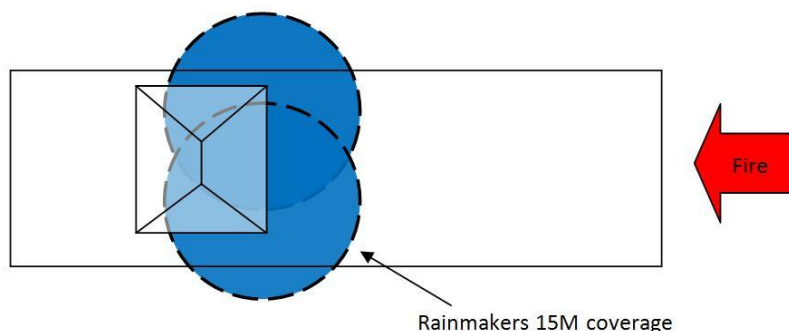


## Connecting Two Rainmakers to a Single Outlet



## **Positioning for best defence**

Determining where to mount the sprinkler for the best effect depends on the approaching fire, attach the hose to the sprinkler and place the rainmaker into position. Test the operation of the sprinkler, by adjusting the spray pattern coverage can be changed significantly. Adjustments are made by using the small screw and by angling the stainless steel flap located above the water stream, experiment with these until you are happy with the pattern.



Maintenance of the rainmaker is simple, lubricate with some WD40 once a year. If the sprinkler does stop spraying, then remove the hex shaped nozzle (where the water comes out) with a 10mm spanner and clear out any debris.
