“RV Daily Tips” recommends that you do not leave the drain valves open on your black or grey tanks. They suggest that you allow your tanks to fill to three-fourths before you dump them. When you empty your tanks, always dump the black tank first. After it empties, flush the toilet a few times to rinse. Then empty the grey tanks. This will flush out the residue left in the lines by the black tank. Make sure both valves are securely closed when you finish.
