



This winter has had its warm days and very cold nights. If the temperature is going to fall below 27 degrees overnight during your stay, fill your fresh water holding tank (or get

a jug of water), turn off your faucet, and disconnect your hose. These simple steps will save you frozen hoses and us frozen faucets. Some campers have used heat tape and insulation on their water hoses. If you choose to do so, the heat tape must also be applied to the faucet itself to be effective. At the end of your visit please turn off your faucet and disconnect your water hose. This is a great help to us and will also help you save from having to replace your hoses. We sincerely appreciate your assistance and cooperation with this matter.

Lake Management had an interesting January with the large storm. The water rose over 3 feet in one day. Thankfully they were able to get back on track in lowering the lake. The lake will begin refilling February 1 at the rate of ¾ inch per day. If you are planning to launch your boat we discourage boaters from using the ramps at Moon and Lighthouse Landings this time of the year. If your camper has a less than fresh smell after being closed up for the winter try leaving charcoal briquettes on saucers around the camper. This will help with moisture and help keep the air fresh. Be sure to use the regular type charcoal, not the “match light” varieties.

Just use a jug of water instead of hooking up your water hose. Also, the bathhouse is open for your convenience. You can pour a little windshield wiper fluid into your drains when you leave and your camper will still be secure from the cold.
