Lake management has successfully followed the rule curve with the **winter draw down**. The lake should be at its lowest point January 15 and remain that way for two weeks.. While the lake is down, we recommend using the boat ramps at the state park or the Highway 34 ramp.

Remember, the **boat slips at Lighthouse** are deep water slips that are usable even at the lake's lowest point. If your boat has been placed in storage, please check to make sure it has a current storage tag. If your tag has been lost, please stop by the store and pick up a new one.

Winter fishing is often overlooked. Fisherman (and women) are telling us they are catching fish. They follow the birds and are having great luck in the deeper channels. We keep minnows and worms available year-round at the store for those who do not mind the winter chill.

As always, we are available for **calls** every day. The emergency phone and store phones for both parks are forwarded to whomever is on call.

The price of **propane** is still at summer prices. If you need your tanks filled or just topped off, drop by or call ahead and we will fill them for you.

There are currently a few **sites available** during this traditional slow time. If you have friends or family you would like to camp with, send them to us and we will get them situated with no waiting.

With cooler temperatures at night, **bonfire** weather is upon us. We have a limited amount of firewood available for use at your campsite. Feel free to help yourself. Nothing says camping more than the smell of a good campfire.

A reminder to all campers, we unhook faucets from the **frost proof spigots** when overnight temperatures go into the mid-20's. The frost proof spigots will freeze. If you put heated tape on your hose, you will still be unhooked from your spigot. Heated tape protects your hose, not the spigot. We recommend filling your fresh water holding tank so you have water during hard freezes.
